

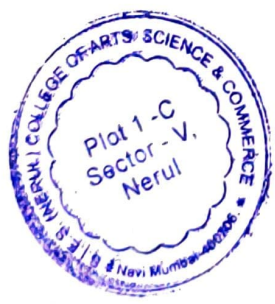

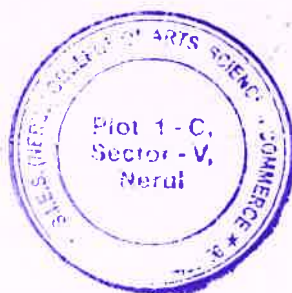

While designing induction program following things should be considered such as participants learning style, principles of learning, target size, trainer's skills, experience, etc.

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6) Preparing the written training and development program design:- A written document providing the details of the induction program should be clear. Details such as objectives, sequence of activities, time allotted per session, etc. to be provided.

7) Preparing participant evaluation forms:- This is to determine the extent to which the induction program has achieved its objectives.

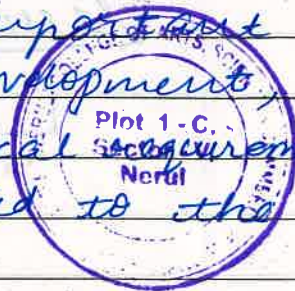
8) Determine the follow-up activities of the event:-

Follow-up becomes an important part in training programme. It provides feedback and support for successful implementation of the programme. The designing should include the range of opportunities and implementation process.

Therefore, the induction program for fresh graduate engineering trainees at SIEMENS is as follows:-

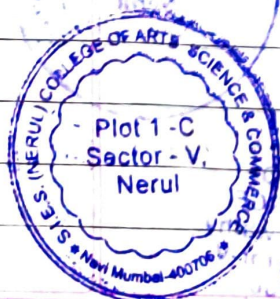
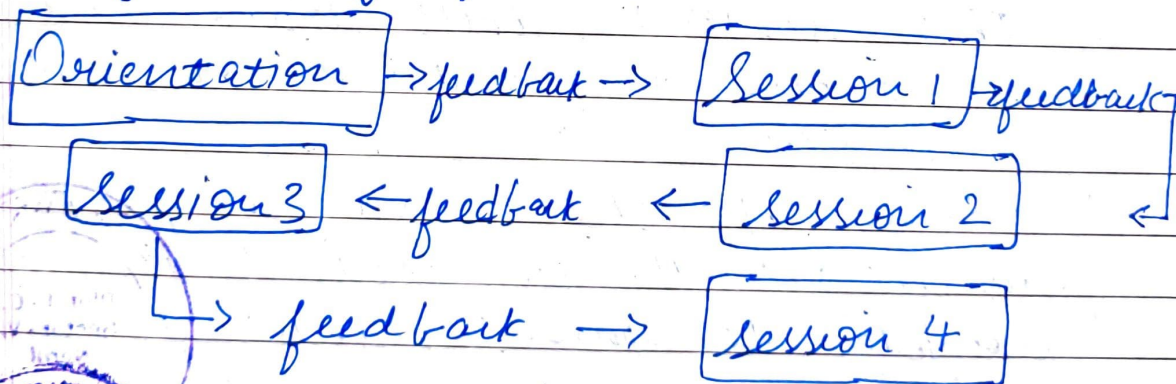

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The process of communication refers to the transmission or passage of information from the sender through a selected medium to the receiver.

The process of communication is cyclic one as it begins with the sender and ends with the sender in the form of feedback.

Communication begins when the sender feels a need to share an idea or thought in his mind. The message could make use of verbal or non-verbal symbols, words or signs.

* Once the sender has decided on his message, he has to plan his process of encoding and the channel for sending the message to the receiver. The sender then decides to use medium on the basis of nature, importance of message.


* After receiving the message, the receiver then decodes the message based on his experiences. He then provides feedback to the sender or responds to him. Communication is said to be effective only when feedback has been provided.

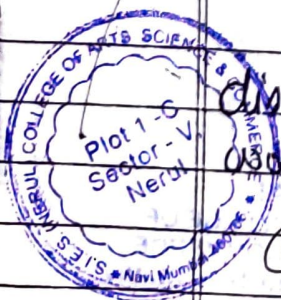
* CASE STUDY 1 :-

In this instance, there is a Vertical Communication between Rajiv and his senior. Vertical Communication takes place among people working on different levels on the line of authority. Initially, lack of vertical communication brought in inefficiency due to apprehension of a non-rewarding system. Later, the vertical communication resulted in indicating in Rajiv the sense that he was not isolated and it radically changed his outlook. Thus, vertical communication helps in building trust between management and the employees.

* CASE STUDY 2 :-

Here, in this case, there is a downward communication between Rahul Shetty and his manager. Because, Downward Communication can be defined as "The flow of information from higher levels of management to subordinate individuals working within an organization." Here, downward communication assumes significance as a means of developing an atmosphere of trust between these two parties. This trust is shaped through information and communication from the management to the employees.

* CASE STUDY 4 :-

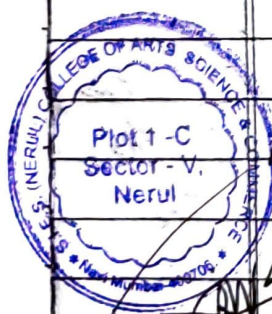
This is a typical instance of horizontal communication or lateral communication. As, organizational communication between people on the same level in the managerial hierarchy may be termed as horizontal communication.

But, when Anil tells them with a reasoning that seems to be advantageous to them they graciously accept the rules. 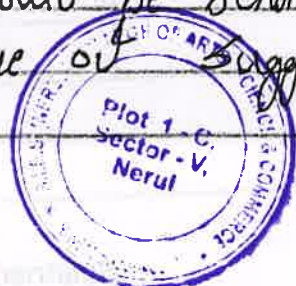

→ (1) Harish suffered from Psychological barrier. His self confidence was too high which cause his downfall.

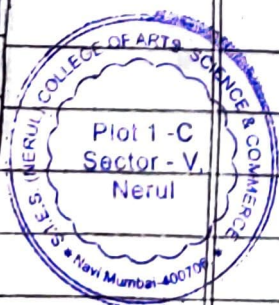

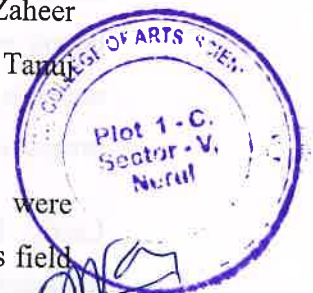
**Report on Symposium on "Impact of Economic Factors and Changing

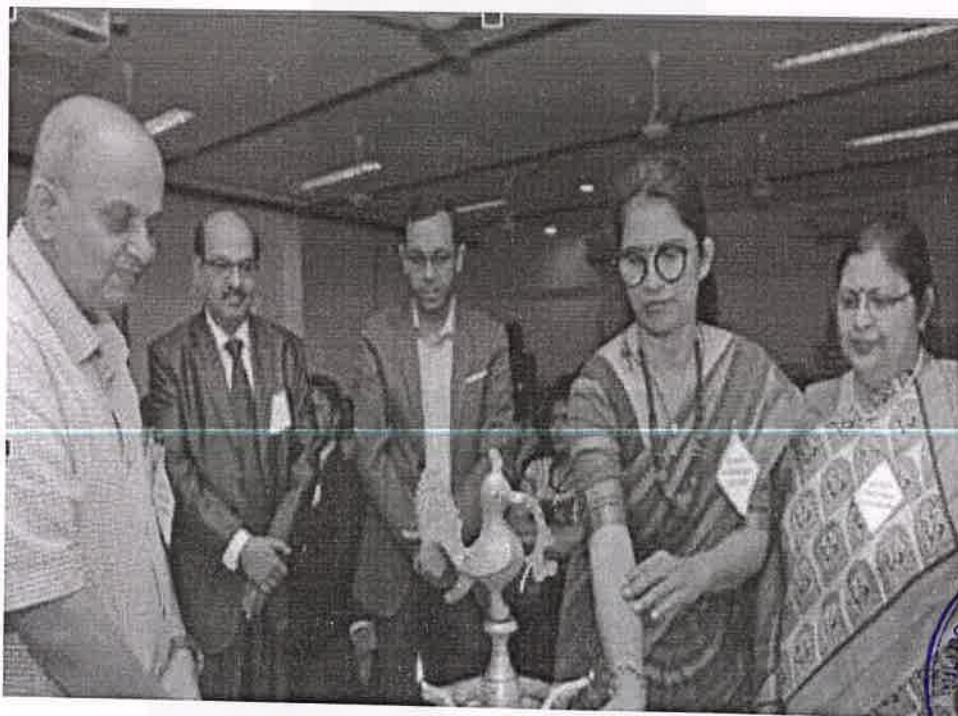


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about the market and guided them about their future. Not only the students and faculty members of SIES ASCN, but also members from other colleges attended the symposium.

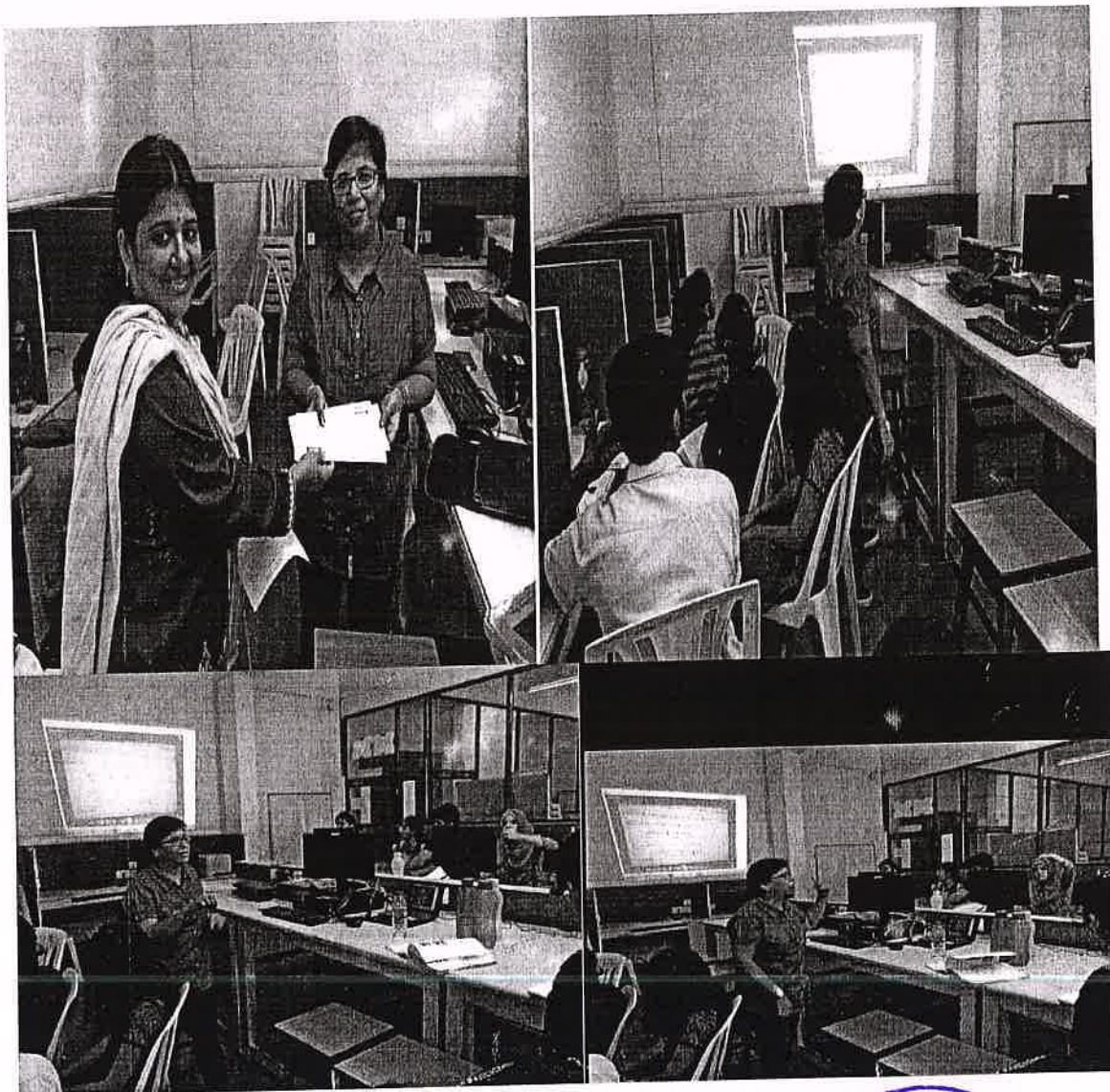

SEMINAR ON INTRODUCTION TO IOT

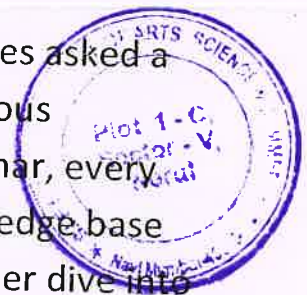
Date: 26th July 2019

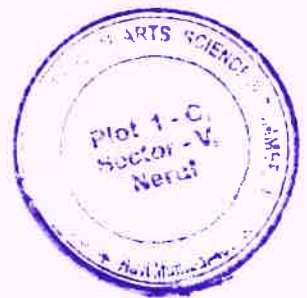

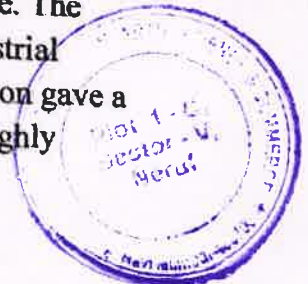
"Brand Building" was a one day workshop arranged by the B.Com Department for the final year commerce students.

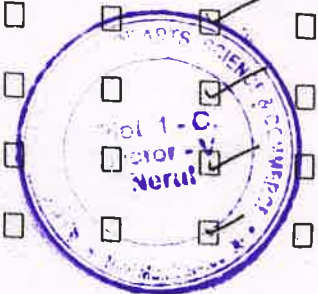

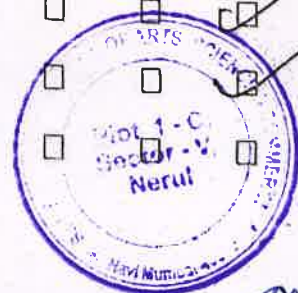

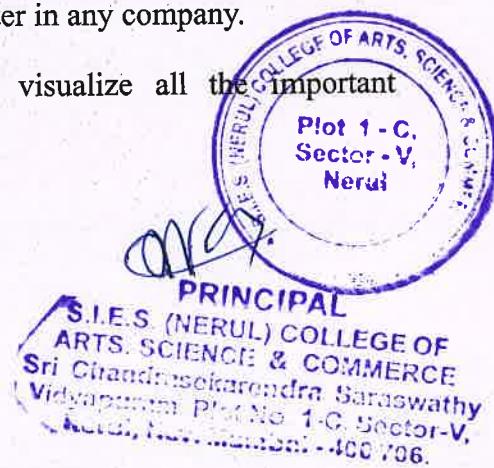
An Industrial Visit to Vasai- Wada region was conducted for the SY and TY B.Com students on 3rd January, 2020.

- 5) To prepare the students for the selection of career path in different departments of industry.

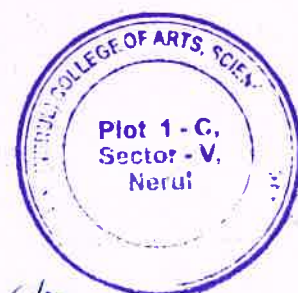

Report on Industrial Visit at BSE Institute Mumbai 3 December 2019

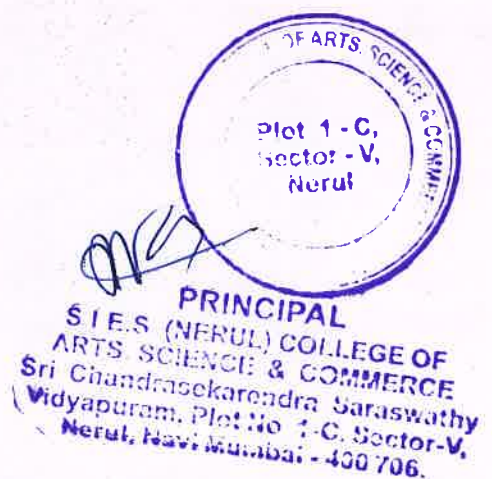



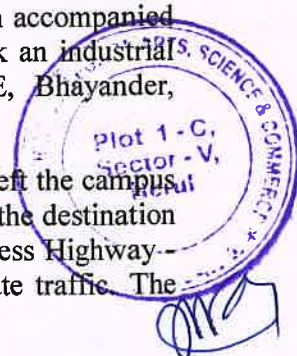
Considering that students of FYBCom are unable to directly relate to subjects like Environmental Science and Foundation Course (section on Ecology in Semester II), it was decided that an Industrial Visit to an Environment Education Centre would help them gain a physical exposure to the contents of the subjects. Thus, the students of FYBCom were taken on a one day Industrial Visit to Keshav Shrushti Environment Education Centre on 6th February 2020.

The Purpose of Industrial Visit was :

- 1) To give the students a contrasting glimpse of urbanized and natural landscape
- 2) To let the students identify the features of urbanized and natural locale
- 3) To encourage a realistic understanding of environmental degradation
- 3) To provide a first hand experience of ecological sanctuaries
- 4) To sensitize the students about CSR
- 5) To allow a hands-on experience of sustainable development to students

On the 6th of February 2020, 56 students (43 girls and 13 boys) of FY BCom accompanied by two faculty members Ms. Rupali Zele and Ms. Ashwathy PVR undertook an industrial visit to KESHAV SRUSHTI- ENVIRONMENT EDUCATION CENTRE, Bhayander, Mumbai.

The students and faculty members assembled at the college gate by 7am and left the campus in a private bus by 7:35am. The ride from the Nerul campus of the College to the destination (via Thane-Belapur Road - Eastern Express Highway - NH48 - Western Express Highway - Mira Bhayander Road - Uttan Road) was about two hours long with moderate traffic. The destination was reached by 9:30am.

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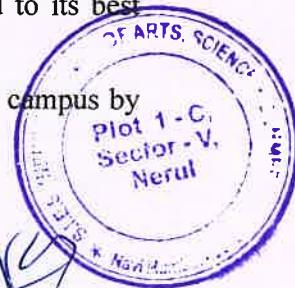
The bus journey from the urbanized locale of Navi Mumbai to the village of Uttan absolutely allowed the students a contrasting glimpse of modernized and natural way of life - the initial visuals crowded with well constructed buildings and roads, busy and traffic jammed streets, and malls were soon replaced with a calm and serene image of thatched roof houses made of bricks, cattle, wells, and countryside roads. Therefore, reaching the destination seemed like being transported to another world altogether.

After refreshments, the first segment of day's schedule included a brief introductory presentation on Keshav Srushti by the tour guide Mr. Abdullah Shaikh from 10:00am to 11am. Thereafter, the students were divided into two groups for the Nature trail - the second segment of the day. In the course of the Nature Trail, the students and faculty members were introduced to different kinds of trees and botanical plants like Water Lettuce, Ghost Tree, Cork Tree, Devil's Tree, etc. Further, the audience was informed at length about Apiculture. Following this was the visit to the agricultural area of Keshav Shrusti, wherein students were informed about the method of drip irrigation for cultivation. Students were practically shown the real colour and texture of naturally cultivated vegetables like tomatoes, cabbage, cauliflower, flame lily, etc. Apart from these, the students also saw a pond adopted for purification process which in turn provided water for drinking, making herbal medicines, cultivation, and watering plants and trees in the area. The next part of the Nature Trail included the visit to the Gaushala which had about 200 to 250 cows. These gaushalas were told to serve the need for milk and milk products in the village, and while the cow dung was used for generating biogas. Finally, the trail concluded with a garden wherein special kinds of flowers were planted to attract and breed butterflies of different kinds, and a last halt to observe a nursery of both medicinal and ornamental plants.

The trail ended by 1:30pm and the entire group took a one hour recess to have lunch, and enjoy the greenscape. The final segment of the schedule was the paper recycling activity which started at 2:30pm. The guides Mr. Abdullah and his friend demonstrated the recycling process to the audience, and then included them in the exercise. Firstly, the participants made a slurry like paste was made by cutting or tearing paper into very small bits, which were then soaked and treated in plain water by rubbing it with bare hands. Thereafter, they mixed the slurry and plain in a 1:1 ratio in a working container. Then, a circular strainer was immersed in the mixture and held out with a portion of the pulp sticking on the outer surface of the strainer. Finally, the strainer was then placed on a surface to leave a circular patch of recycled paper, which, when dried under sun for two hours, was to be ready to use. By 4pm, all the students had made a circular sheet of paper.

Finally, after some recreational games, the students and faculty members stopped to purchase vegetables cultivated in the fields, as also some ayurvedic products like oil, soaps, incense sticks etc made out of the milk, plants and herbs cultivated at Keshav Shrusti. The reluctance of the students while leaving the premises and their discussions regarding the observations made during the day testified that the environmental concepts like ecology, life cycle of plants and trees, food web, sustainable development and such had become more relatable. This in turn indicated that the purpose of the industrial visit was accomplished to its best level.

The group started their return journey at around 4:50pm and reached SIES Nerul campus by 7:30pm.

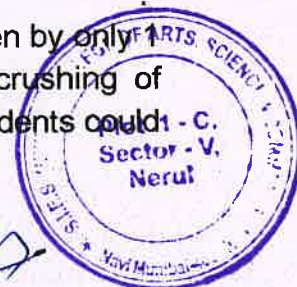

This was followed by a visit to the RBI Monetary Museum.



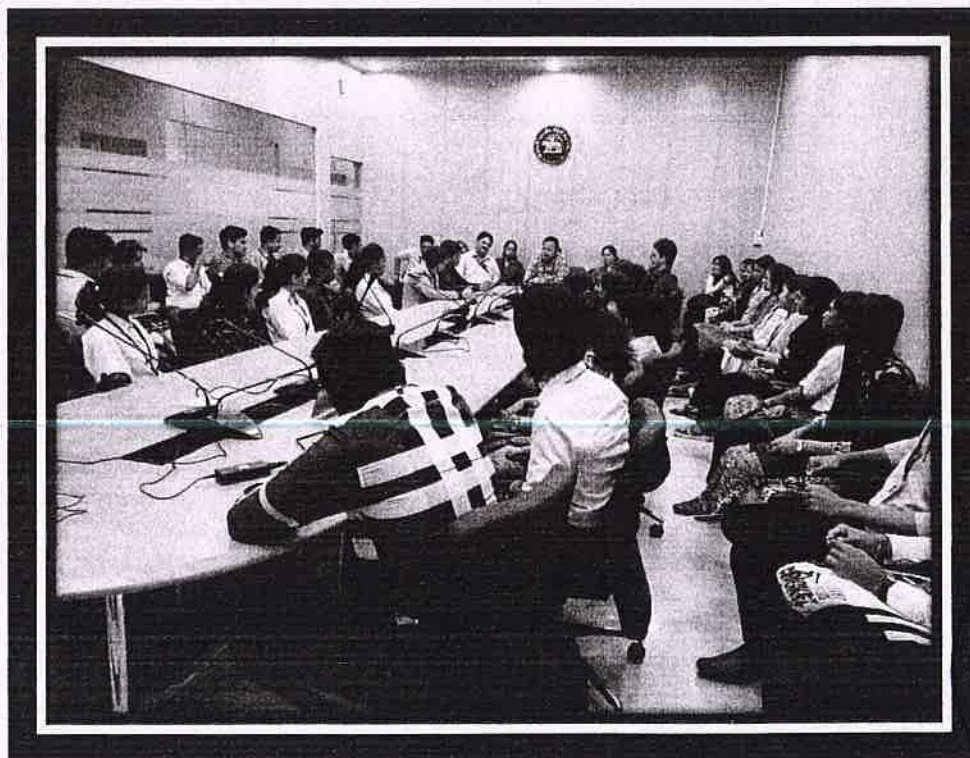

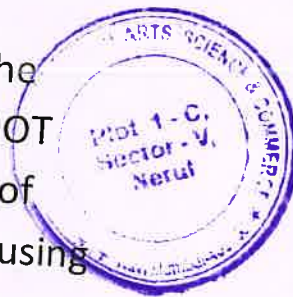
SEMINAR ON PROJECT DEVELOPMENT

The events commenced just after the inauguration event. Students of other departments participated in these events. The registration of the events was



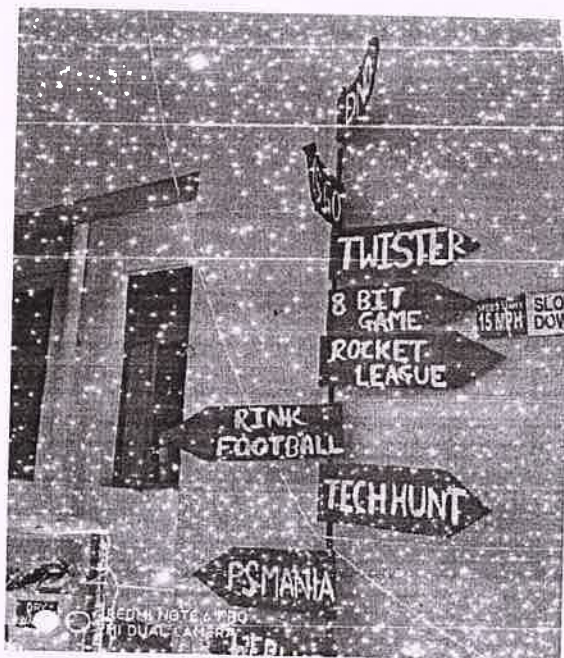
