RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. AREA OF OPERATION

The area of operation of "S.I.E.S. (NERUL) COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION" shall be or further as may be decided by the Managing Committee from time to time.

2. MEMBERSHIP

I. Any person who has been student of S.I.E.S. II. The Association shall have the following classes of Members:

- a. **LIFE MEMBERSHIP:** Any eligible person who can become a member of the association is eligible to become a Life Member provided the person agrees to abide by the Rules and Regulations as may be in force from time to time and pays the enrolment fees of Rs. 500/- or as decided at the time of enrolment to the Association.

3. REGISTER OF MEMBERS (LIST OF MEMBERS)

The Association shall maintain at its registered office, a Register of all its members and shall enter therein, within 15 days after the admission of a member or the cessation of his/her membership as the case may be. This membership register shall be produced at the time of General Body meeting for the verification of the General Body.

4. CEASING TO BE A MEMBER:

1. It shall be the member's responsibility to ensure that his/her subscription is regularly paid and the Association will not be bound to intimate any member of any arrears of subscription. 

In the absence of Secretary, the Joint Secretary shall act as the Secretary and shall do all the functions as that of the Secretary and shall perform all the duties of the Secretary or be/the joint secretary otherwise.

C. TREASURER AND JOINT TREASURER:

Treasurer shall perform following duties:

- i. To receive subscriptions, donations, gifts, charities, fund etc., and to record the receipts in the Cash Book maintained for the purposes.
- ii. To receive all payments made to Association and to pass all necessary receipts for the same.

vi. To keep not more than Rs.5000/- as cash with him and excess thereof to be deposited in the Bank Account of the Association.

To help and advice the Managing Committee of the Association in all financial matters and also administration of the Association.

viii. To assist and help the Secretary and Chairman in all matters relating to the duties of them. In their absence to function according to the instruction given by them.

It. Treasurer shall assist and help the Treasurer in all matters relating to the duties of the Treasurer and in his absence to function according to the instructions given by the Treasurer.

8. POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE:

The Powers and functions of the Management Committee in particular shall be as follows:

A. SPECIAL POWERS:

a) Powers to sale, mortgage, lease or dispose of the Trust Property

The Managing Committee shall have power to alienate, mortgage, lease Trust properties for the purpose of or on behalf of the Association, only with the previous sanction of the Charity Commissioner and/or any other authority required by the law, subject to compliance made. Provisions of Section 36(I) of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 shall be complied with.

b) Power to purchase the moveable and immoveable property:

The Managing Committee shall have power to purchase the immovable property/properties for the purpose/object of the Association. The Managing Committee of the Association shall invest the funds after approval of the General body and the sanction of the Charity Commissioner and/or any other authority and subject to such conditions and limitations as may be imposed by the said authority in the interest of the Association. Provisions of Section 35(1) of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 shall be complied with.

c) Power to taken Loan

The Managing Committee shall have power to borrow money including bank borrowing or take loan (whether by way of mortgage, pledge, hypothecation or otherwise) for the purpose of or on behalf of the Association, only with the previous sanction of the Charity Commissioner and/or any other authority and subject to such conditions and limitations as may be imposed by the said authority in the interest of the Association. Provisions of Section 36(A)(3) of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 shall be complied with.

d) Power to employ persons/agents:

It shall be competent for the committee members, at their uncontrolled discretion, instead of acting personally to employ and pay any person/agent (Including any Bank, Solicitors, Attorneys, Legal Advisors, Architects and other professionals or any persons) to transact any business or to do any act whatever in relation to the object of the Association including the receipt and payment of money without being liable for loss.

e) Utilization of Trust Funds



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10 MEETING OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE:-

Members of the Managing Committee shall meet ordinary once in four months if necessary to conduct the affairs of the said Association. Minimum seven days notice of the meeting in writing by hand delivery should be given to the members of the Managing Committee.

11. REQUISITION MEETING OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE

On Receipt of the requisition, the Managing Committee shall forthwith proceed to convene the meeting. If, Managing Committee fails to do so, then the Chairman, and/or requisitioners themselves may convene such meeting within 10 days from the delivery of such requisition. Quorum for the requisition meeting shall be 2/3rd members present in the meeting of the Managing Committee.

12. QUORUM FOR THE MANAGING COMMITTEE

Five of the Total number of the members present in person at any meeting of the Managing Committee shall for Quorum. In the event of such quorum is not present within half an hour of the time appointed

13. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES:

The number of Trustees including the Author of the Trustees shall not be less than five and not more than twenty persons. The Board of Trustees shall nominate and invite person/persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.

14. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:


These Trustees shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the board of trustees.

15. CHAIRMAN:

There shall be a Chairman for the administration of this trust, nominated by the board of Trustees, who shall be one amongst trustees as specified in para (4) above for such period, in such manner as may be specified in this behalf.



a) All property of the Trust Movable or Immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in trust, the trustees shall manage the whole property and affairs of the trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the trust.

b) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the trustees shall for the purposes of this trust have the following powers, duties and functions:

- i. To acquire by Gift, Grant, Purchase, Exchange, Lease, or otherwise lands, buildings, or other immovable properties and also any Movable Property.
- ii. To construct and maintain buildings, to alter, demolish or improve them and equip them suitably.



- iii. To accept gifts, donations, endowment and contributions for the Trust and shall be treated as the income of the Trust.
- iv. To raise loans, to receive monies, securities or other movable property on behalf of the Trust.
- v. To accept any trust, trust fund or endowment so long as the provisions of such Trust or endowment are in consonance with the objects of this Trust.
- vi. To award scholarship and make donations calculated to promote the objects of the Trust.
- vii. To enter into contracts, or engagements on behalf of the Trust.
- viii. To consider such proposals submitted by Sub-committee appointed by this trust and allocate such funds if necessary as deemed necessary for the implementation of the programs.
- ix. To make, sign and execute all such documents instruments, as may be necessary or proper for carrying on the management of the properties and affairs of the Trust. (viii) To invest such monies and such funds of the trust and to vary the investment as and when it may seem necessary or proper provided that such investments shall be made only upon immovable properties or upon securities as the board of trustee may deem fit, under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.
- x. To sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the trust provided all the trustees unanimously resolve that it is in the interest of the trust to do so to sell or lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of any movable and immovable properties of the Trust.
- xi. To appoint a Committee /Committees of management for such terms and with such powers as may be specified from time to time, for carrying on the routine management of the affairs of the Trust.
- xii. To appoint such employees on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may deem fit for carrying out the work of the trust and exercise control all such employees including the power of suspension, dismissal and removal.



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- c) The costs of ordinary repairs and for providing any amenities to the buildings for the time being forming part of the trust property.

25. APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST:



ii. Any additions, alterations or omission in the rules and regulations of the Association shall be effected by a Resolution of the Association by two third of the members present in person and entitled to vote at a Special General Body Meeting duly convened for the purpose.

Any additions, Alteration, amendments, omission, extension or abridgements in the Memorandum of Association of the association shall be effected as per the provisions of Section 12 & 12(a) of the Societies Registration Act.

The Managing committee will have powers to frame such Scheme u/s 50(A) of the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950.

29. DISSOLUTION:

In the event of dissolution of winding up of the Trust the assets of the trust remaining on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstance be distributed among the Trustees, but the same shall transferred to other Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.

30. PRIVILEGES OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS:

- i. The Committee members shall, as long as they are attending to the affairs of the Trust and devoting their time and attention to the facilities, traveling and such other incidental aid.
- ii. Reimbursement : The Committee members for the time being may reimburse themselves, himself or herself and pay and discharge out of the funds or moneys in their hands all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or powers herein under or matter or affairs relating to the conduct, management and administration of the Trust.




KAIZEN WAVE REPORT




CLEAN-UP DRIVE REPORT

- It was a satisfying experience for all.





The E-certificates was given to the students through the mail after the end of Webinar



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

