VISIT TO RELIANCE CORPORATE PARK

The students of BAF have “Company Law” as a part of their SY syllabus.

OBJECTIVE: In order to offer the students a practical insight into a few aspects of Company Law, a visit to Reliance Corporate Park, the Ghansoli-based nerve centre of the Mukesh Ambani led Reliance Industries Group, which houses the offices of Petrochemicals, oil & gas, Retail and Jio businesses was organized on Friday, 20 December 2019.

Around 60 students (9 TYs and 51 SYs) accompanied by a faculty visited RIL. The Secretary of SIES (Nerul) College of Arts, Science & Commerce Alumni Trust was instrumental in making this endeavour possible.

The students were provided with an overview on Corporate laws, guidance on pursuing courses like that of the CS, CA, CMA, CFA, CFP, etc. Mr. Sudhakar Saraswatula, Vice President - Corporate Secretarial and his team offered guidance to the students. He talked about the importance of self confidence. He also discussed how it is important to make your own career path with your capabilities, identifying your strengths and weaknesses, improving on what you lack.

OUTCOME: The session was taken over by Mr. Aditya Subramaniam, a CS and alumnus of SIES –BAF. He took the students through the practical aspects of compliances like conduct of Board Meetings, by showing sample records and video clippings. The students got the experience of almost real-life Board meeting and company affairs. The purpose of organizing the visit was achieved in full.

The students actively participated in the sessions which went beyond the allocated time. Prior to the session, the students were taken on a private bus tour of the 506 acre office campus.

This was a rich experience for the students.

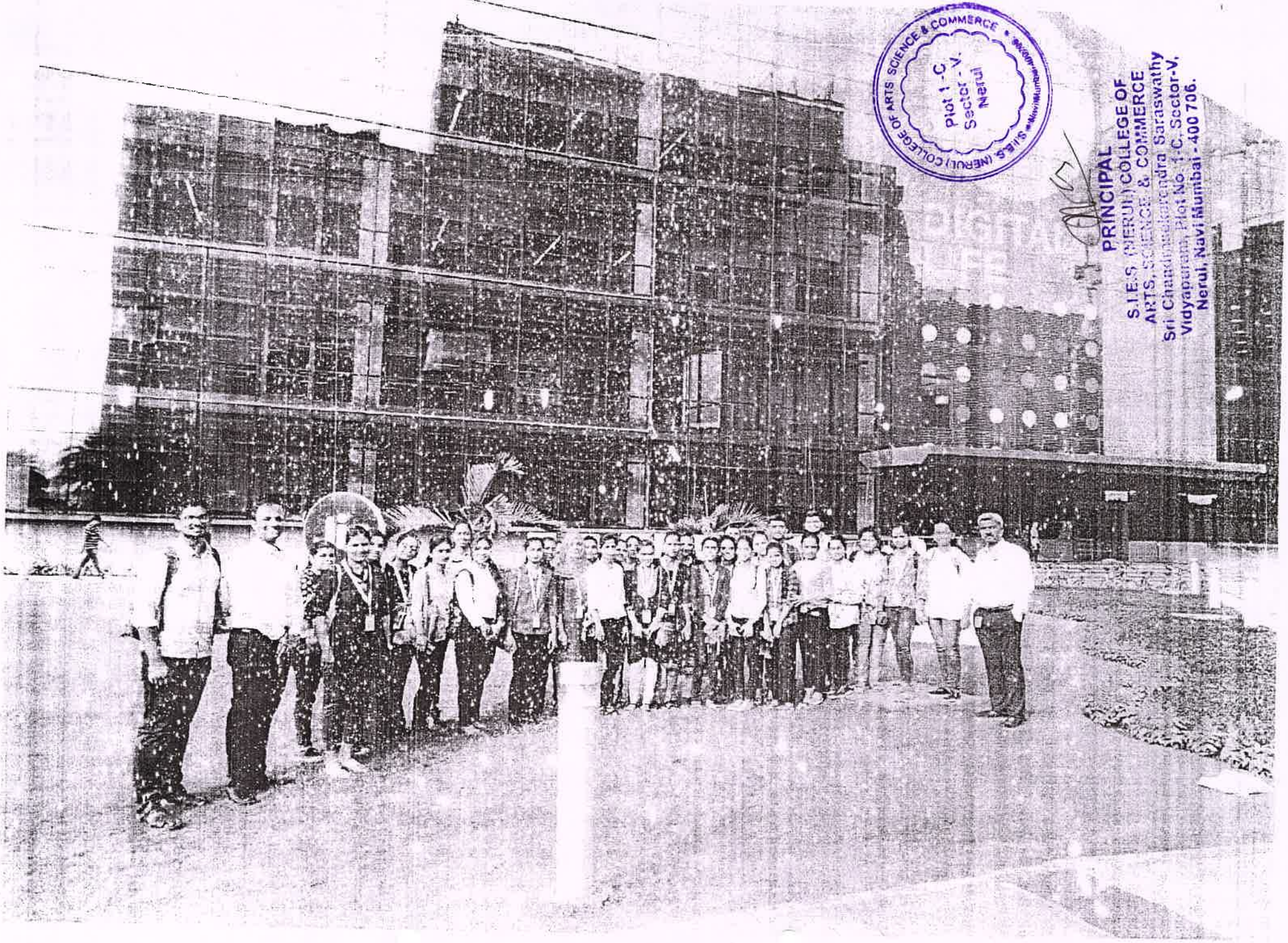

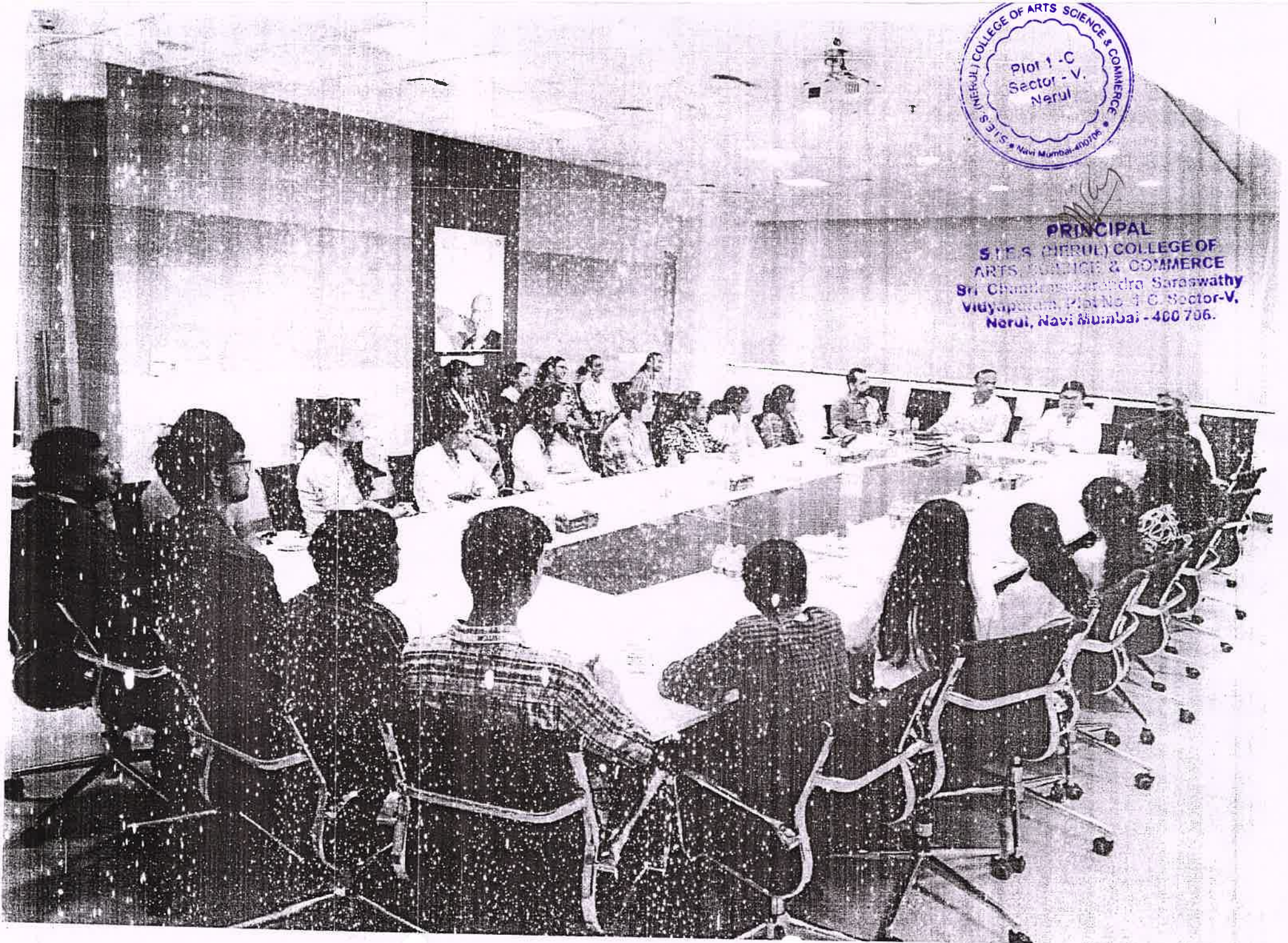

g) AES, DES, RSA and Diffie-Hellman Key exchange algorithm

→ 1) AES:

AES stands for Advanced Encryption Standard. It is the current US standard in symmetric block cipher. AES uses 128-bit (with 10 rounds of encryption), 192-bit (with 12 rounds of encryption) or 256-bit (with 14 bit rounds of encryption) keys to encrypt 128-bit blocks of data.

Features of AES are:

- 1) Symmetric key symmetric block cipher
- 2) Stronger and faster than Triple-DES
- 3) Provide full specification and design details
- 4) Software implementable in C and Java

2) DES:

DES stands for Data Encryption Standard. It is a symmetric-key block cipher published by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST).

DES is an implementation of a Feistel cipher. It uses 16 Feistel structure. The block size is 64-bit. Though, key length is 64-bit, DES has an effective key length of 56-bit.

(b) Encrypt the message by raising it to the depth e^{th} power modulo n . The result is a ciphertext message C .

(c) To decrypt ciphertext message C , raise it to another power d modulo n .

4) Diffie - Hellman Key Exchange Algorithm:

The Diffie - Hellman algorithm is being used to establish a shared secret that can be used for secret communications while exchanging data over a public network using the elliptic curve to generate points and get the secret key using the parameters.

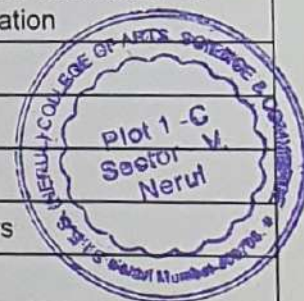
- For the sake of simplicity and practical implementation of the algorithm we will consider only 4 variables one prime P and G and two private a and b


- P and G are both publicly available numbers. Users (say Alice & Bob) pick private values a & b and they generate and exchange it publicly; the opposite person received the key and generates a secret key after

REPORT ON IQAC STRESS MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

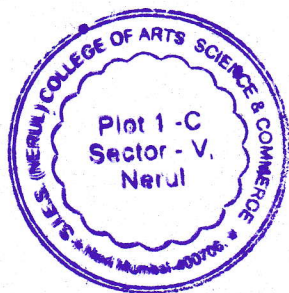

The session ended with Vice-Principal of the college, Dr. Koel Roy Choudhary giving away a vote of thanks.

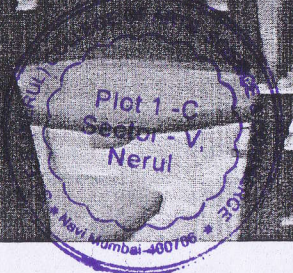
In true senses, the session turned out to be extremely informative. The students while giving their feedbacks had requested the college management to organize many more such prolific sessions in near future.
