

National Service Scheme 2014

The NSS unit of SIES (Nerul) College of Arts, Science & Commerce began its academic year with the event Street Play on the occasion of Anti-Drug Day on 10th July 2014. On 23rd July 2014, the NSS orientation was conducted. The rules and regulations regarding NSS were explained to the new volunteers. The significance of NSS badge as well as the various activities which are conducted by NSS were also explained.





'Blood Donation' drive was conducted on 31st July 2014.

The NSS unit in collaboration with TATA MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, Kharghar collected 90 bottles of blood. On the same day a workshop was conducted on Anemia by the doctors of TATA MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, Kharghar.

The MAVA (Men against Violence and Abuse of women) Orientation was conducted on 30th July 2014 by Dr. Harish Sadani who is spearheading this movement in Maharashtra. Thirty NSS volunteers were selected for this movement with 2 male heads who will be coordinating the activities of the movement in the college.

The next event on the NSS calendar was **'Tree Plantation'** which was conducted on 11th August, 2014. The tree plantation site was Ambedkar Udyan, Nerul . The NSS volunteers cleared the pathways, planted over 50 saplings and leveled the ground in various parts of the garden.

A **Fire safety Drill** was also conducted on 13th August 2014 by Prof. D.G. Phodnekar Co-co-ordinator NSS Cell Mumbai University. The drill was conducted to demonstrate safety measures and precautions against fire .



The students were taught how to put out fires at home using blankets and gunny sacks .They were also taught how to use fire extinguishers which are commonly available in buildings to put out fires.

Then, on 23rd August 2014 The NSS Unit organized a guest lecture on **Disaster Management** . Ms. Pranali of ANIRUDHA ACADEMY OF DISASTER MANAGEMENT (AADM) was the guest speaker.



She explained the different types of disasters and also explained the mitigation steps to be taken during each disaster. Around 50 NSS volunteers along with r faculty members attended the lecture.

The BRM (Blue Ribbon Movement) Orientation was conducted on 30th August 2014. The 1st Session MAVA conducted on 1st September 2014 to discuss programs and events for the year.



On 1st September, 2014 the BAF Department of the NSS unit visited the old age home **'Matru Sadan'** at Nerul and the volunteers put up a cultural show and interacted with the elderly occupants of the home. Visit to old age home
