- 1. Dr Koel Roychoudhury began the proceedings by speaking about the new regulations related to institutional autonomy and how the college is on the verge of being autonomous fulfilling almost all the required criteria as per University norms. She spoke about the vital and challenging role of the IQAC in acting as a roadmap once the college becomes autonomous. On getting autonomous status, the college will introduce new under graduate programmes under science discipline from academic year 2023-24
- 2. Dr.Koel Roy Choudhury mentioned that an Expert Committee Visit for Extension for the two new post graduate courses namely, M.Com (Business Management) and M.A (Business Economics) was successfully conducted on 13th February 2023. Hence two new programmes- M.Com (Business Management) and M.A (Business Economics) will be introduced from academic year 2023-24.
- 3. Prof. K. Venkataramani stated that college should be prepared for Autonomous status and should introduce new programmes from next academic year. He further suggested planning for NEP implementation programmes by organizing seminars on topics such as curriculum development and innovative teaching pedagogies.
- 4. Dr. Raman Bala (Parent Representative) highlighted importance of skill based learning under the New Education policy, 2020.
- 5. Mr. Bharat Iyer (Alumni representative) shared his view that the work related to autonomy and the points discussed in the earlier meeting had all been taken care of. He agreed that the autonomy process would lead to increased responsibilities and well defined structure.
- 6. Dr Koel Roychoudhury mentioned that the academic year 2023-24 will be the 25th year of the college since its establishment and hence a momentous one and accordingly academic activities would be planned department wise.
- 7. Ms. Bhumika More presented budget for academic year 2023-24. Professor Venkataramani suggested increasing revenue budget so that every month innovative activities could be planned for the 25th year of the college.
- 8. Dr. Koel Roy Choudhury placed the findings of reports of external academic, administrative, gender, Information Technology (IT) and Environment and Green audits conducted on 10th April 2023.

- 1. Ms. Bhumika More began the proceedings by introducing the members present. She introduced the new external members- Dr. Raman Bala, Creative Director Actor, Arts & Entertainment, NMIMS and stated his accomplishments. Next, she introduced Ms. Vrushali Magdum and her immense contributions to social welfare were spoken about. She further introduced faculty Ms. Nutan Sawant and Ms. Neelima Balchandran (Librarian) along with Ms. Shreeya Kulkarni TYBMS and Ms. Keetika Maurya TYBAF as Student Representatives. All the guests were welcomed and thanked for their presence.
- 2. Ms. Bhumika More started with a power point presentation about the IQAC objectives which are drafted to align with the New Education policy and focus on quality education, its composition for the academic year 22-23, the recommendations made by the NAAC peer team and the various initiatives/action plan undertaken in alignment with the suggestions given. - 3. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury opened the discussion by speaking about the roadmap put forth by SIES President V. Shankar for initiating the preparations for SIES University. She also mentioned the status of the college regarding its application for autonomy and the changing UGC regulations in this context. Autonomy would enable the college and IQAC to make a shift from traditional courses to market driven ones and bring in the required dynamism in the system.
- 4. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury informed that new committee such as Equal Opportunity Cell, Zero Waste Management, Maths Association, Academic Audit Committee and Project and Consultancy Committee were constituted from the academic year 2022-23.
- 5. Dr. Koel RoyChoudhury informed that a 3 percent reservation will be provided for Transfer Cases, Sports Achievers (State / National /International), Cultural Activities (State / National / International), Divorcees / Deserted women and physically handicapped students from this academic year.
- 6. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury informed about how the college geared up and planned for offline lectures and various activities. Ms. Ananya Gon spoke about the efforts of faculty members in helping students to acquaint them with the industry norms especially post covid.

Dr. Koel Roychoudhury further mentioned that college has already applied for M.Com in Business Management and MA in Business Economics and is awaiting for its Local Enquiry Committee visit.
- 11. Dr. Koel RoyChoudhury informed that NAAC has approved the proposal sent for organizing State Level NAAC sponsored Seminar on Curriculum and Design which will be organized on 8th December 2022 by IQAC.
- 12. Dr. Koel RoyChoudhury suggested that to enhance the effectiveness of mentoring, seminar for the faculties of the college should be organized. She also mentioned that new formats for mentoring should be designed for better documentation purpose.
- 13. Dr. Koel RoyChoudhury proposed that E-content development and delivery (4 Quadrant Approach) is becoming important to reach out to students on digital platforms. Dr. Meghna Bhatia said that training will be provided to all the faculties to develop e-content.
- 14. Dr. Koel RoyChoudhury mentioned that College will host 55th Youth Festival of University of Mumbai in the month of August 2022.
- 15. Bhumika More informed that in order to develop emotional balance and handle exam stress effectively, especially to cope up with post pandemic, seminars will be organized for final year students of graduate programs in the month of August and September 2022.
