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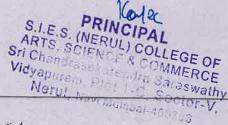

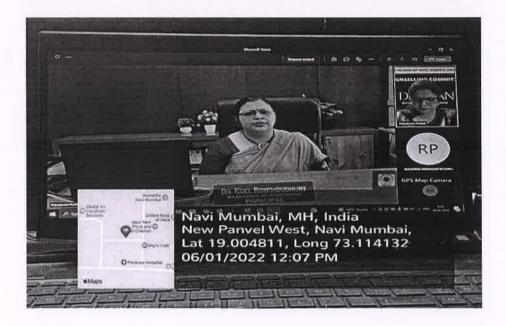
Later, the participants were asked to fill a feedback form and the event concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr.Padmaleela Damaraju.

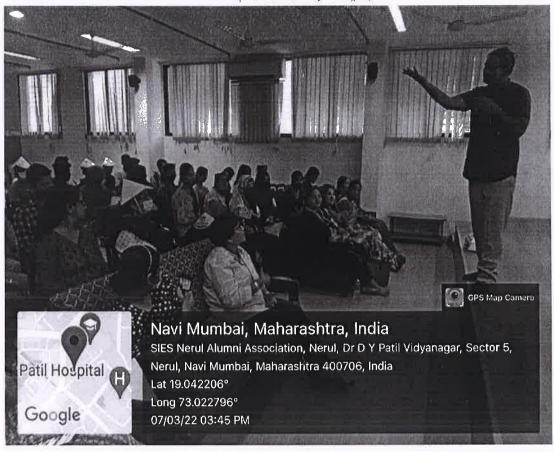
A session of meditation was organized by IT Department for the students of First year and Third Year, introducing the students to mindfulness, self-realisation and a peaceful lifestyle.

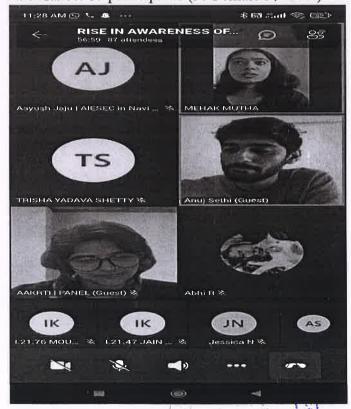
#### Brief:

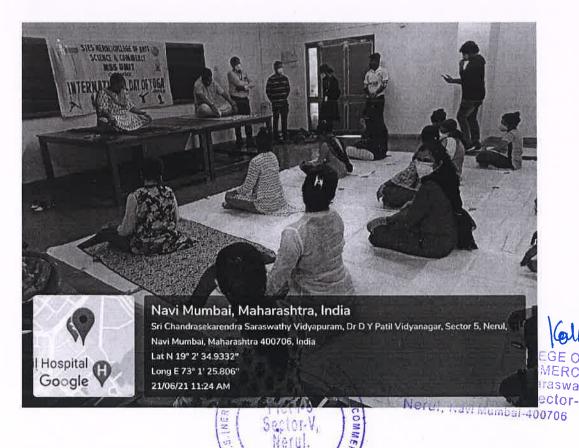

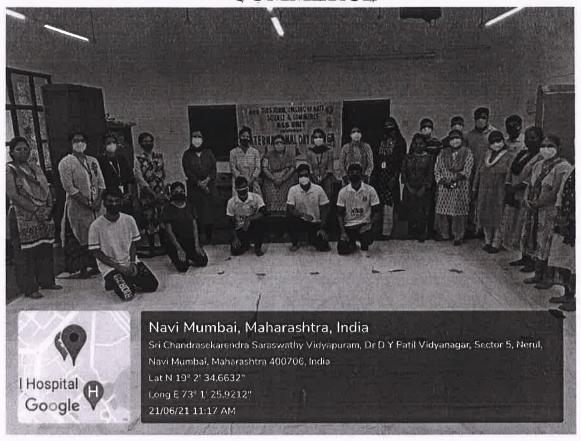

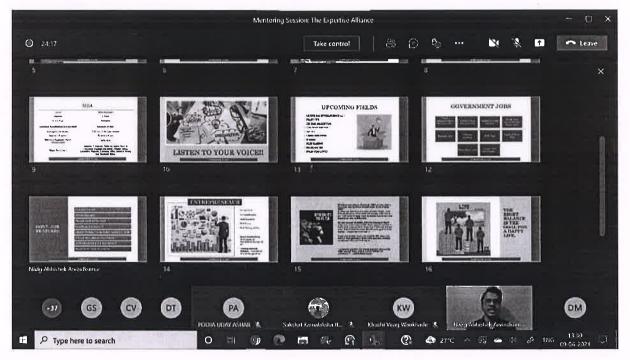
#### **Mentoring Session**

The event was conducted on 27th October, 2021 virtually via the MS Teams platform. The event began at 11am sharp and concluded by 12.15 pm. There were 286 attendees apart from the organizing committee who graced the session.

The host for the event was Tracy who began by introducing the guest speaker of the day, Ms. Sonal Modi, and the agenda for today's event to our audience and teachers. Shortly after, the event began with the lighting of the lamp and short prayer. The host of our event, Tracy then invited our principal, Ms. Koel Roychoudary to speak a few enlightening words about today's event and then proceeded to introduce our guest speaker, Ms. Sonal Modi. After the brief introduction, Ms. Koel ma'am revealed the brand-new logo of the GSC. The logo was designed by Ms. Ashta, who was the winner of the Logo making Competition conducted earlier by GSC. In her speech, she spoke at length about menstruation and the hygiene practices that one should follow while dealing with periods. She also explained to us the importance of Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) and also shed light upon the fact that MHM practices were essential for our environment as well as our health and well-being.

Then, our speaker proceeded to talk about one of the most important yet often neglected issues of menstrual hygiene. She explained to us about how we should frequently change the sanitary napkins/ tampons/ menstrual cups every 4 to 6 hours and also thoroughly clean the area to prevent any possible infections. She also guided us on how to dispose of a used sanitary pad properly. Ms. Sonal also suggested various Yoga postures that girls and women may follow while menstruating to get some relief from the painful cramps. Thereafter she proceeded to speak on the ways to manage periods which consists of the traditional way which our mothers and grandmothers followed, the modern way which we are accustomed to and the new age solutions. She elaborated on the life cycle of sanitary napkins and the harm that it poses to our environment.

She familiarized the audience with sustainable options such as cloth pads, menstrual cups and tampons and explained the correct method to use cloth pads and menstrual cups. Lastly, she demonstrated to us on how to properly use a menstrual cup and also informed us about its many advantages. As we reached towards the end of our event, Ms. Sonal Modi also held a question- and-answer session with our audience so that everyone could get their doubts cleared. Thereafter, Dr. Neera Kumar, GSC Convenor, expressed a vote of thanks in respect to our guest, attendees and organizing committee of the Gender Sensitization Cell. 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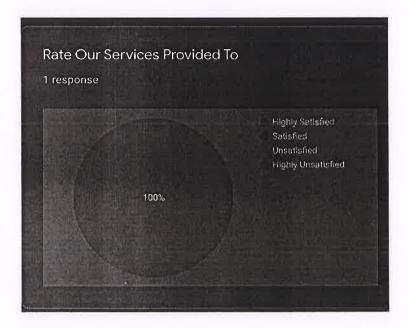


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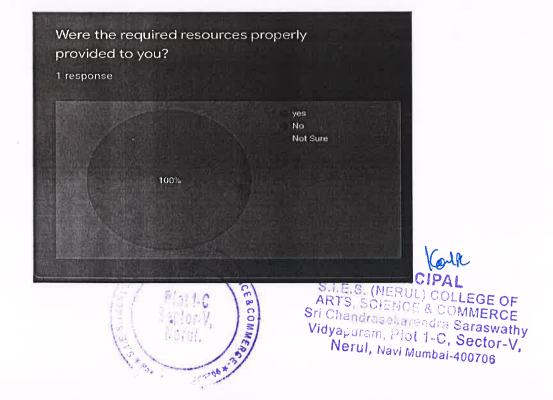
#### **GUEST FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

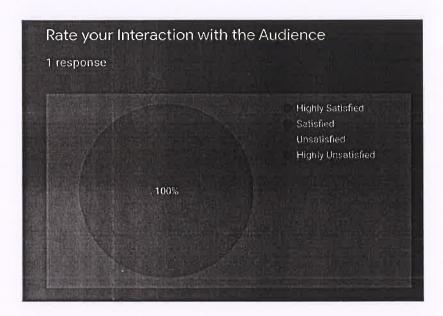
After the webinar a feedback form was circulated to the guest speaker. From the review of the speaker we have concluded these observations.



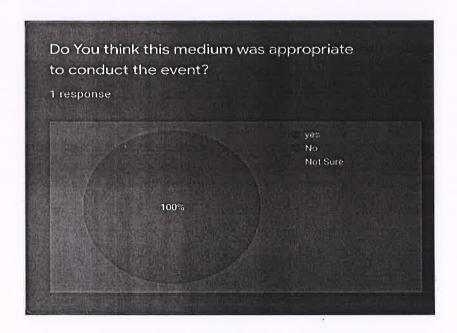
According to the feedback given by the guest she was highly satisfied with the services we had provided her.

In the above pie chart we can see that the guest was highly satisfied with the kind of interaction she had with the audience.



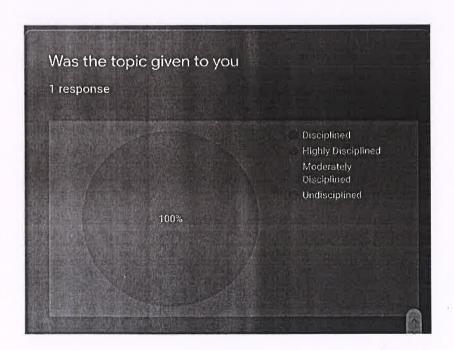
According to the given feedback, the guest of the webinar thinks that the medium provided to her was appropriate to conduct the webinar.

The workshop was very helpful for all the Teaching & Non-Teaching staff & was a huge success.

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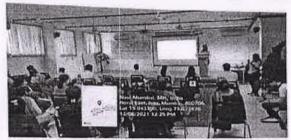

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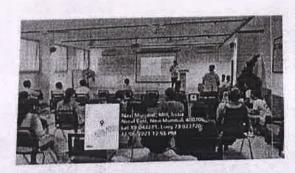
