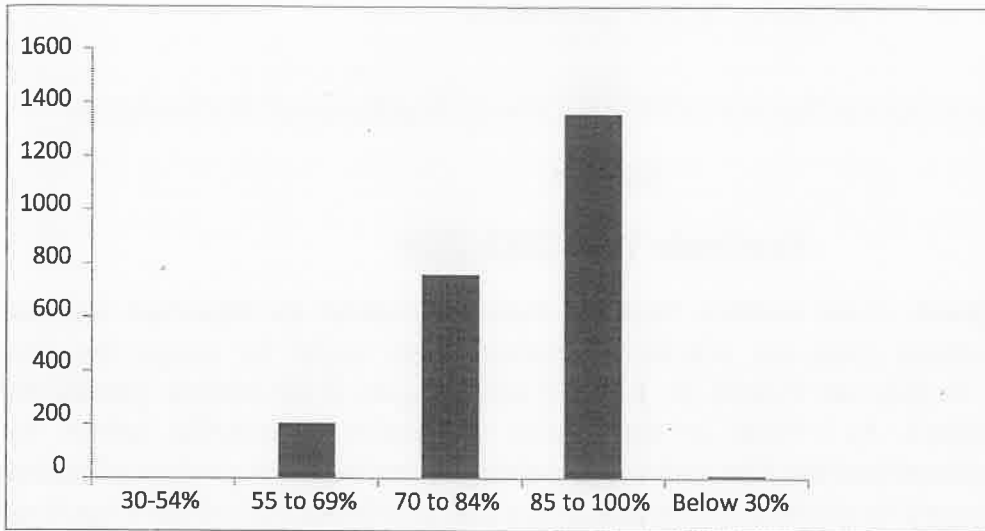
Total Number of Respondents: -2364

Reponses – Program wise



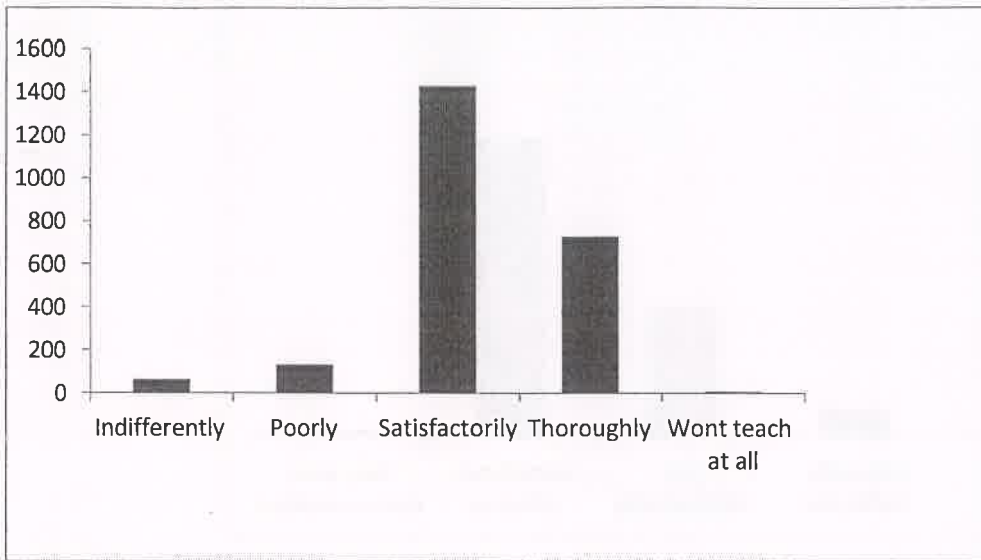

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

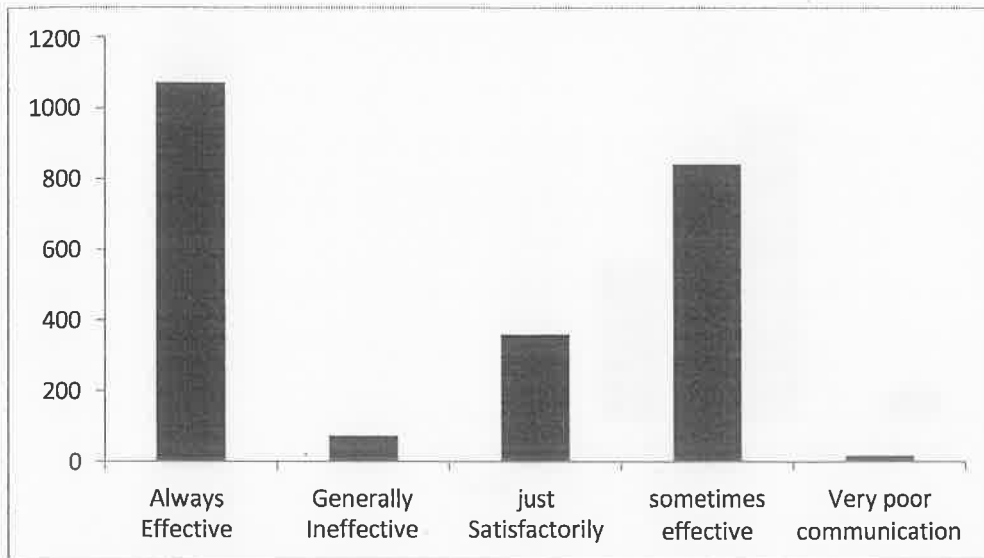

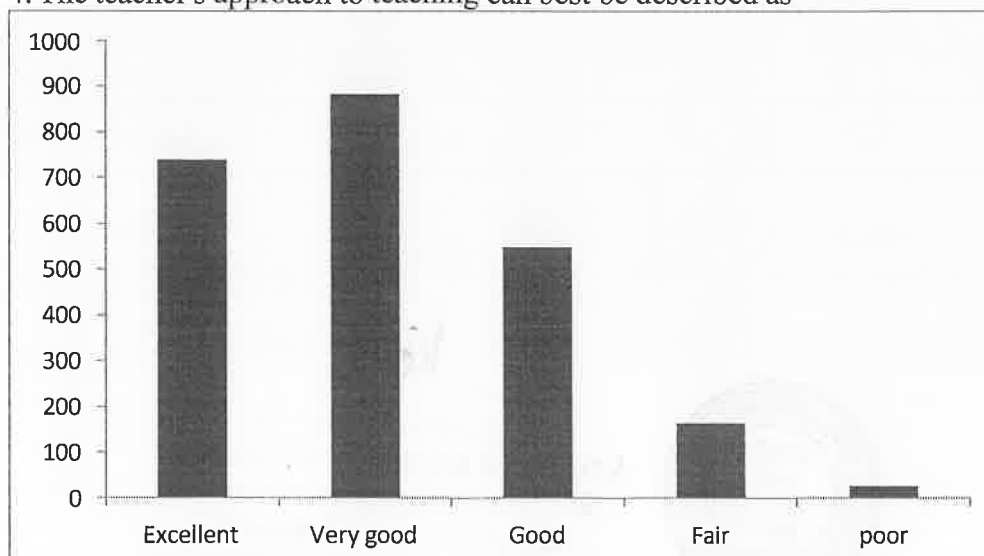

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



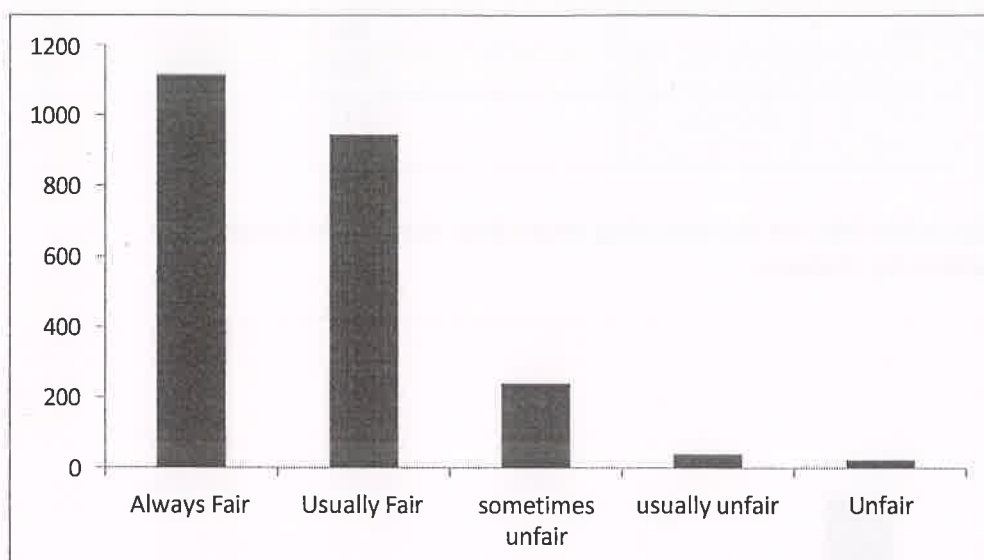

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



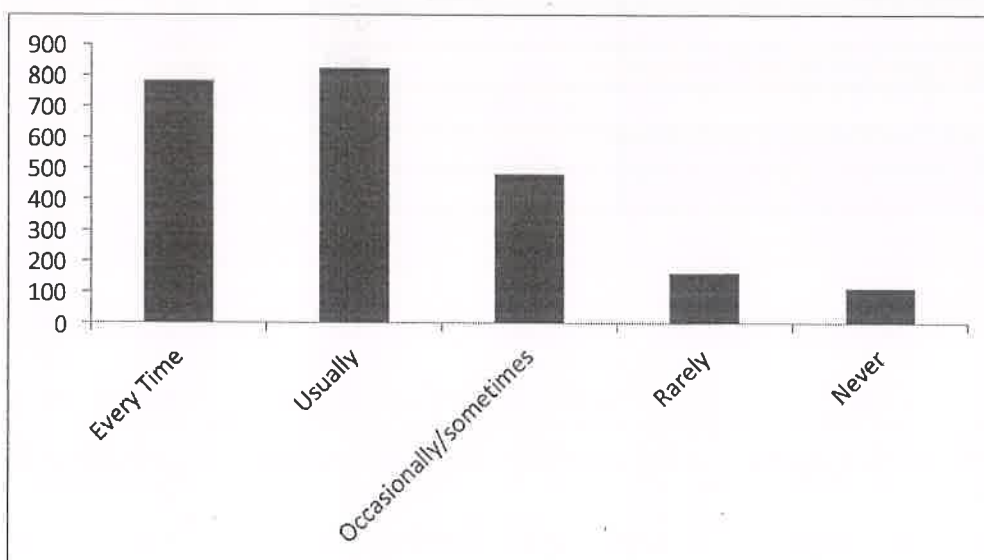

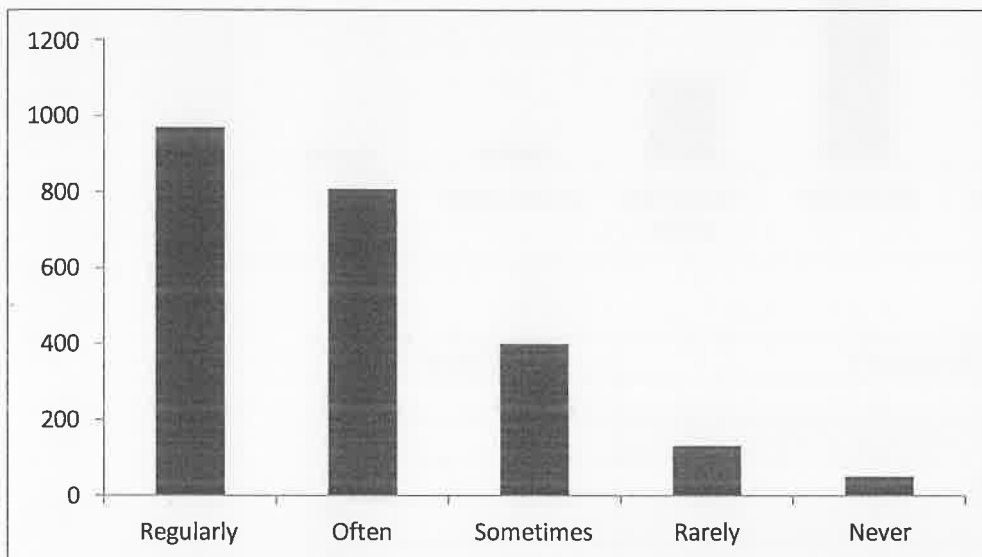
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

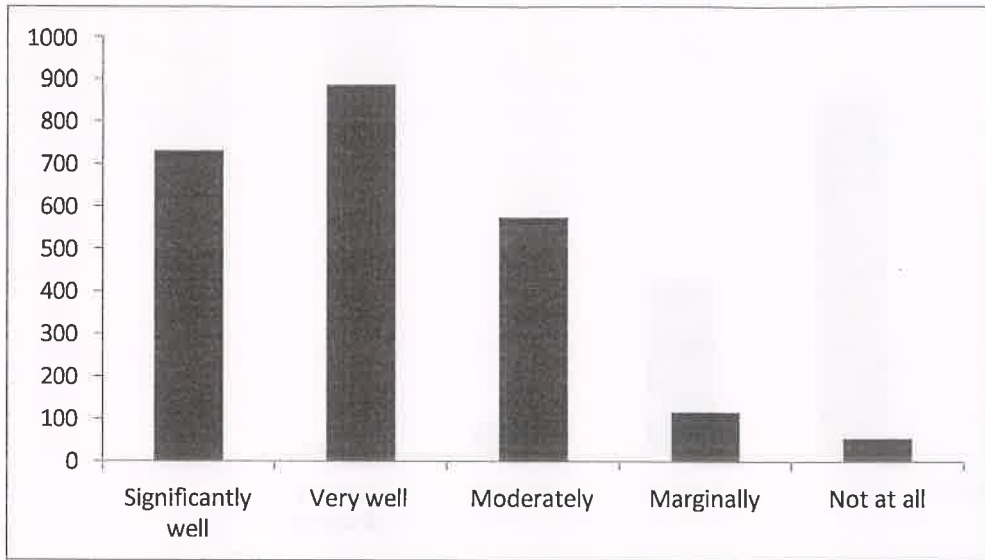

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilities you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

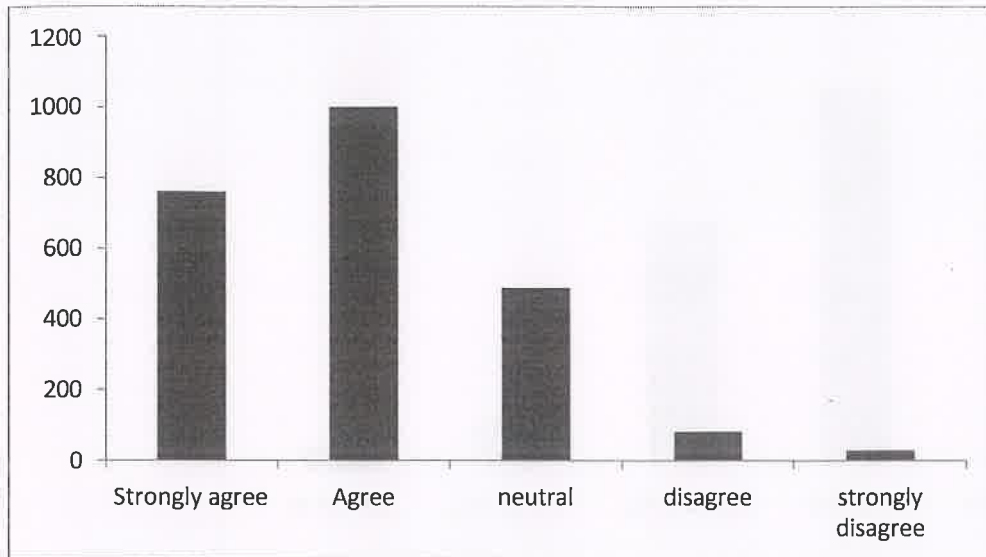

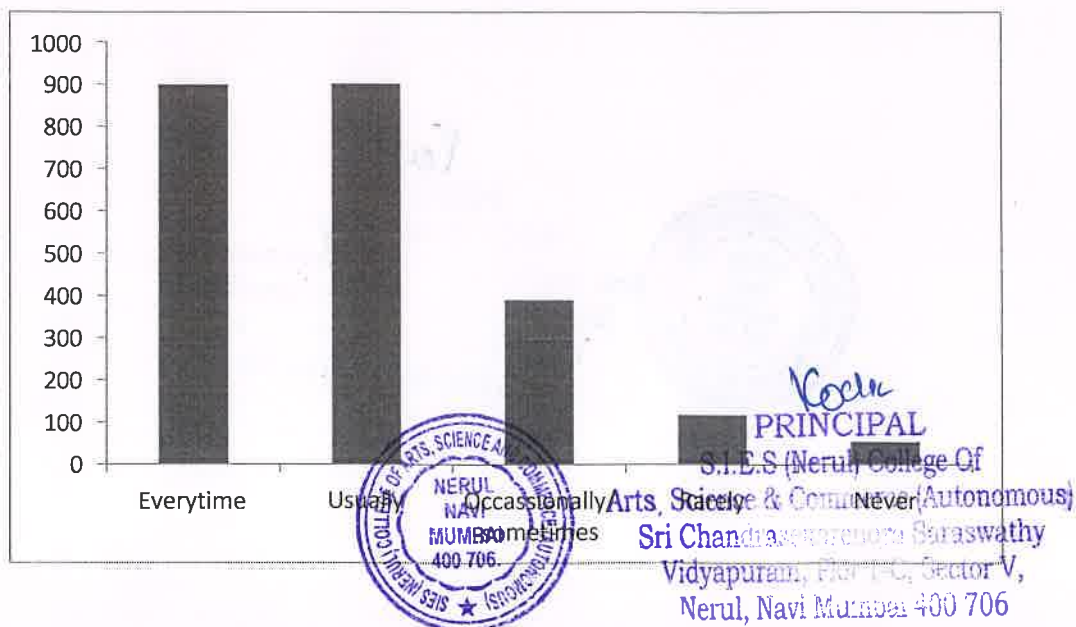

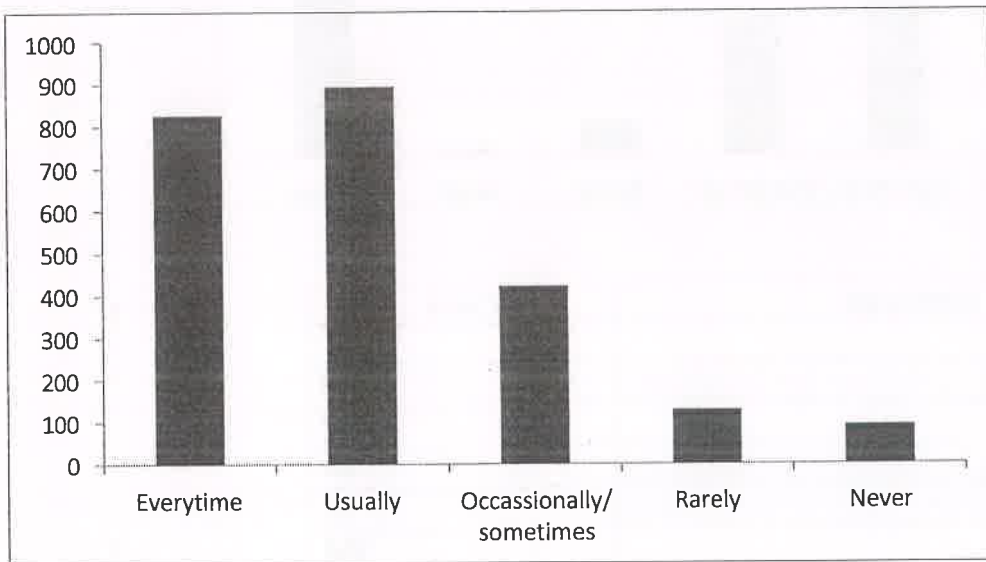

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

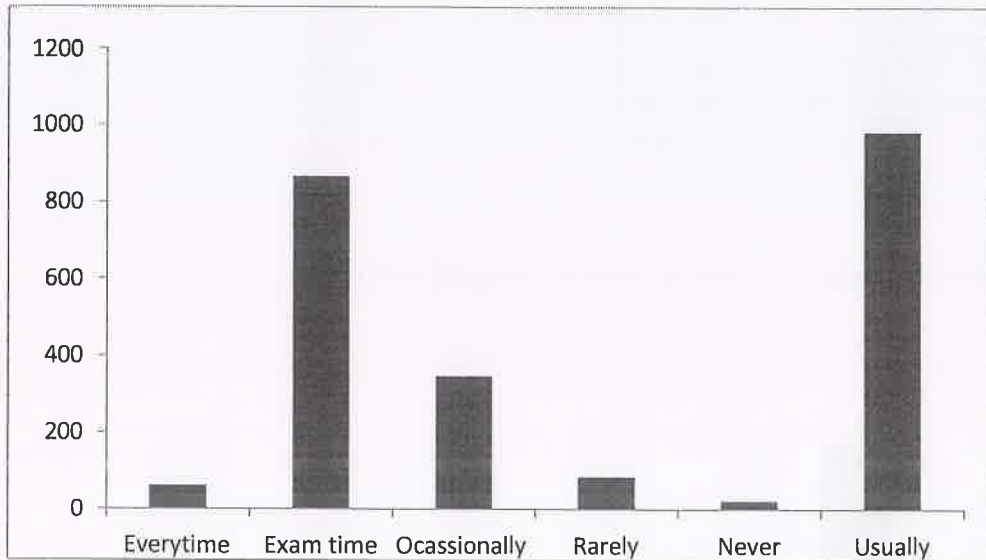

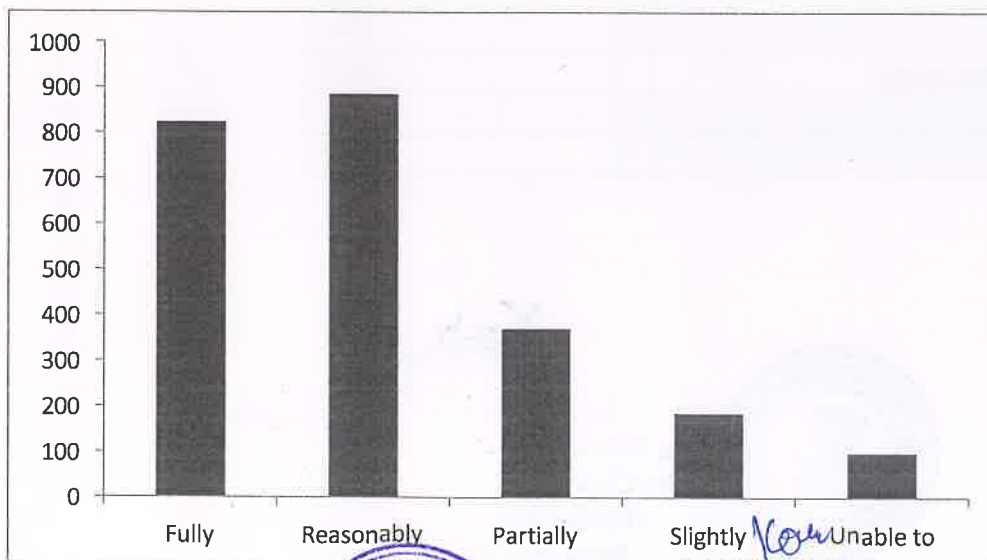

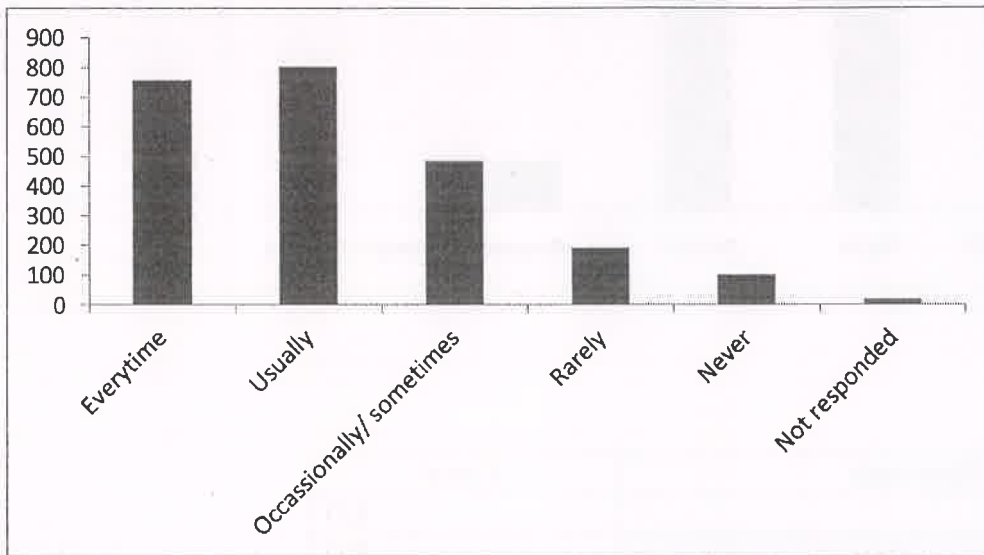

14. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help you to overcome them.

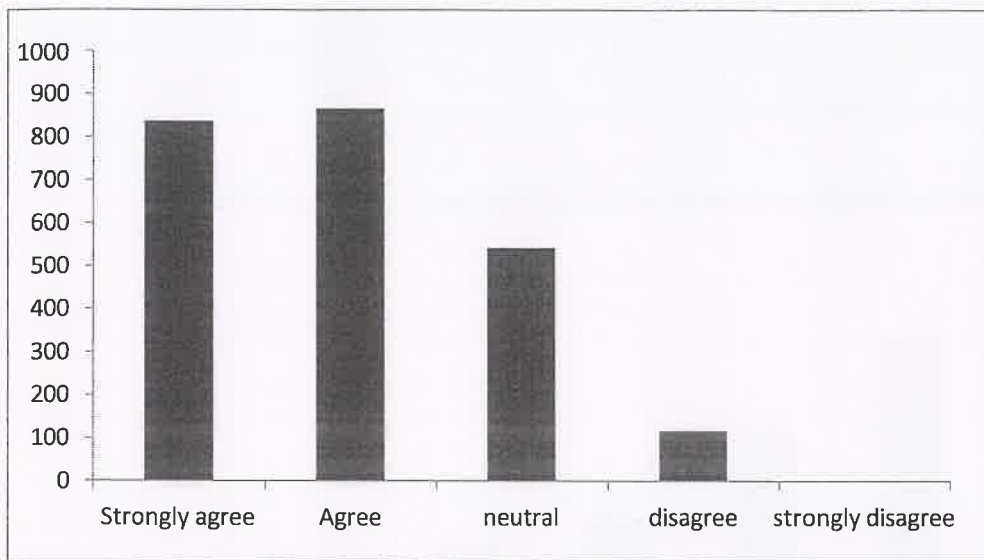

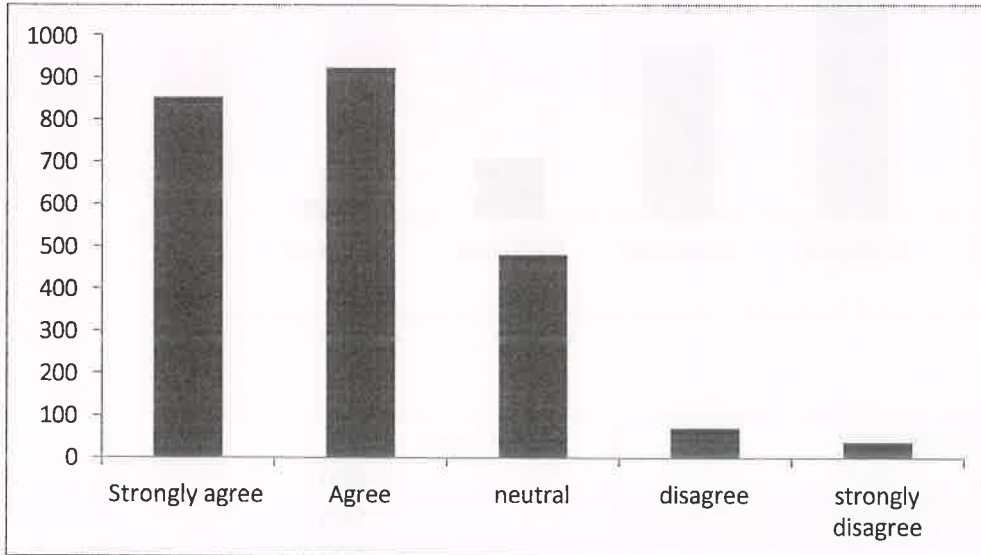

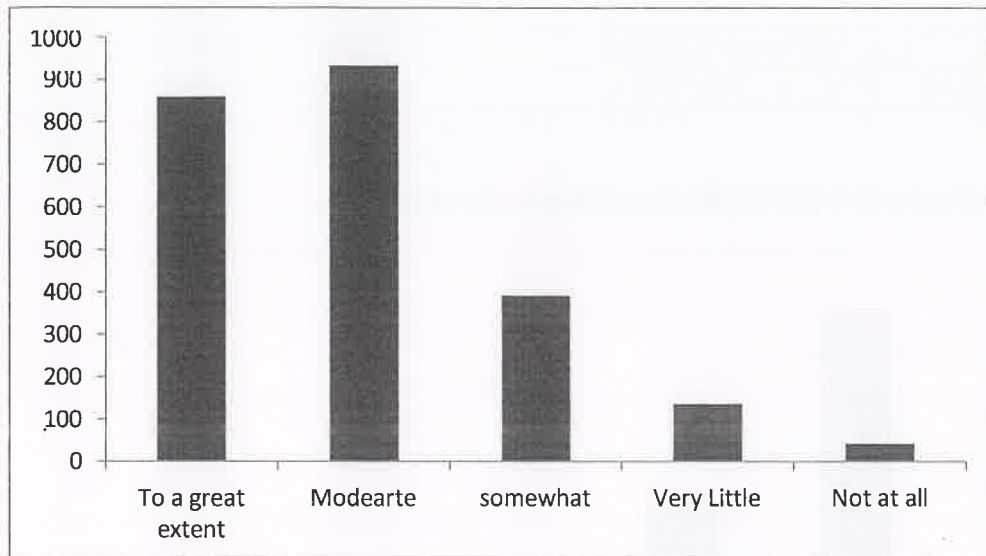

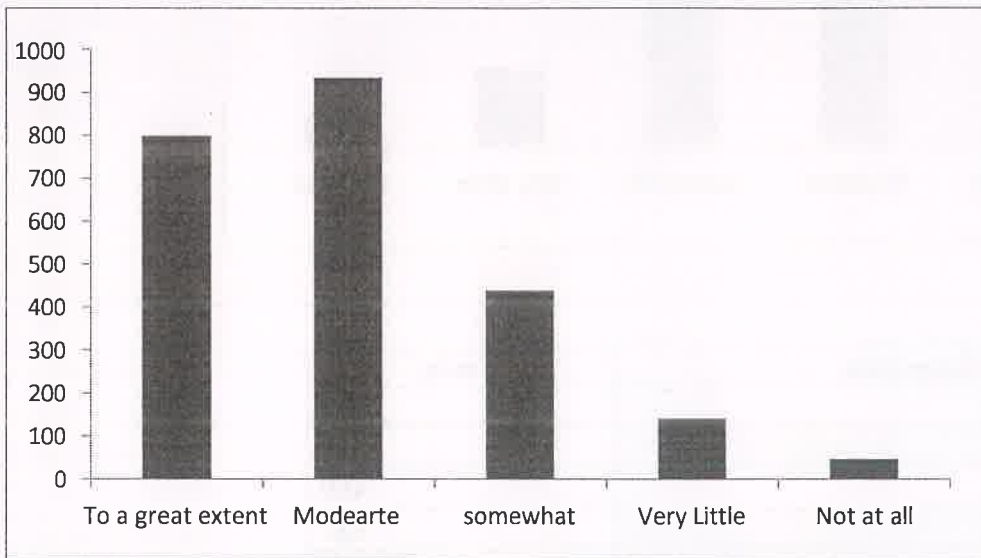
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

20. Was the teacher able to adapt with online teaching?

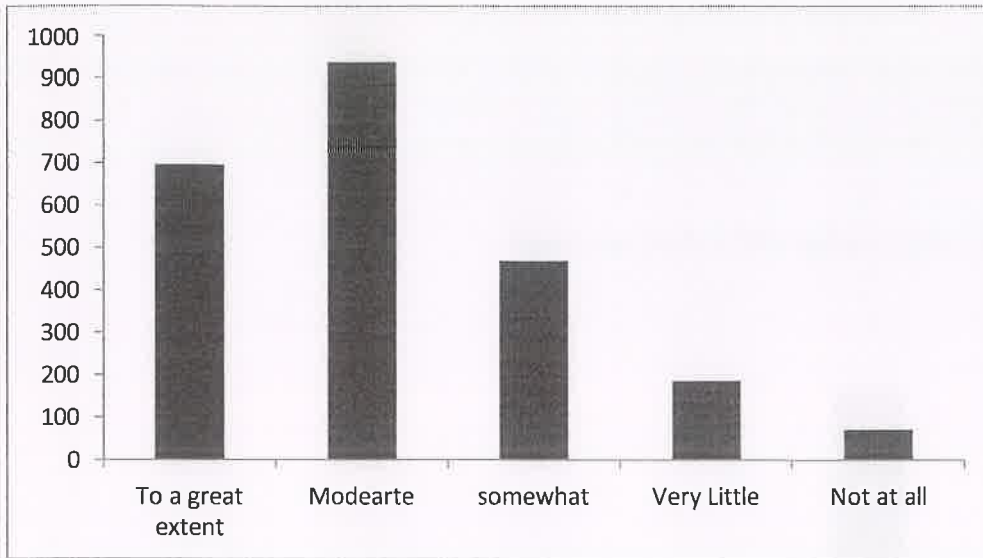

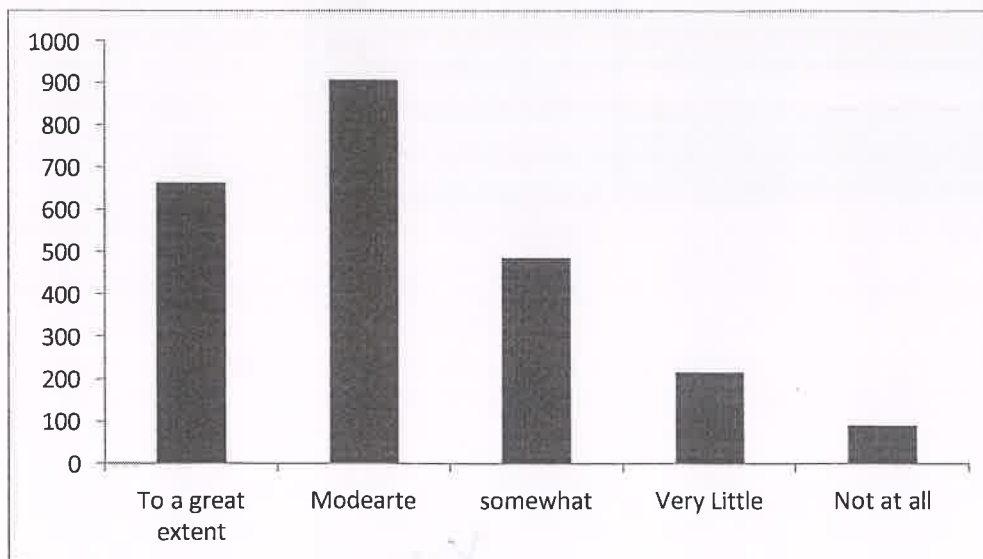

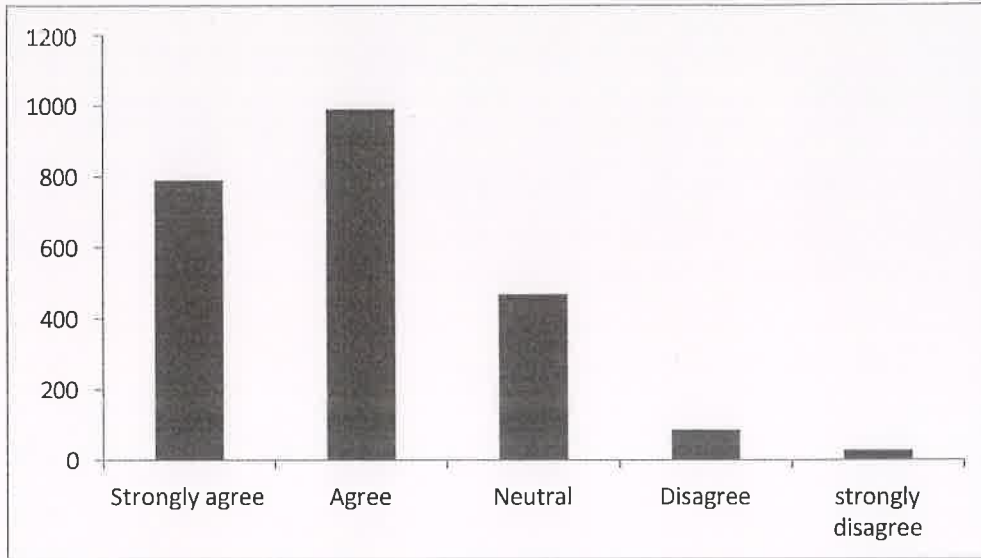
22. Was the teacher using innovative methods of teaching through ICT?


