- 1. Ms. Bhumika More began the proceedings by introducing the members present. She introduced the new external members- Dr. Moushumi Datta Principal Nagindas Khanwala College. Next, she introduced Mr. Vansh Mehta, Global financial reporting Analyst, Blackrock as industry representative and Mr. Shlok Shinde as alumni representative. She further introduced faculty Ms. Mushira C. and Mr. Vinod Nair along with Ms. Rajeshri Yadav TYBI and Mr. Pranay Gadhave TYIT as Student Representatives. All the guests were welcomed and thanked for their presence.
- 2. The Minutes of the Meeting held on 15th April, 2023 were confirmed.
- 3. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury expressed with happiness that the UGC conferred the Autonomous status to the college. She opened the discussion by stating that Autonomy would enable the college and IQAC to make a shift from traditional courses to market and practical driven ones and bring in the required dynamism in the system by designing new courses. She further mentioned that as per Maharashtra Government and University guidelines, all autonomous colleges need to implement NEP 2020 from academic year 2023-24. Hence, our college would also be prompt and implement NEP 2020 from academic year 2023-24. Under the guidance of Principal and IQAC convenor, the NEP Implementation Coordinator was appointed alongwith NEP Implementation Committee for the smooth conduct of activities.
- 4. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury informed that an orientation for all staff members was conducted on guidelines for implementation of autonomy and NEP 2020. Koel RoyChoudhury gave a detailed explanation about all the verticals to be introduced for first year students under NEP 2020. As per norms given by UGC and Government of Maharashtra, verticals were implemented and 22 credits were offered to all first year graduate and post graduate students.
- 5. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury informed that statutory committee such as Board of studies as per 10 departments, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Governing Body would be constituted from the academic year 2023-24 as per the compliance of UGC.
- 6. Ms. Bhumika More mentioned that IQAC objectives would be drafted to align with the New Education policy and focus on quality education, and the various initiatives/action would be planned in alignment with Autonomy and NEP2020.
- 7. Prof. K. Venkatramani suggested that the Institutional Development Committee should be constituted so that institution Development Plan could also be aligned with UGC requirements. The college plan and preparedness implementation Education Policy 2020 was then discussed.

- 9. Dr. Moushumi Datta suggested that faculties will need to know about industry based as well as skill based curriculum. Seminars for syllabus designing should be conducted to help faculties frame market oriented syllabus for first year students.
- 10. Mr. Vansh Mehta suggested taking a feedback on implementation of NEP 2020 from students to understand their perceptive on NEP2020.
- 11. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury suggested that as an autonomous college, the feedback committee should also take feedback of syllabus from other peer autonomous college. It was decided to include feedback from other autonomous college alongwith feedback from students, alumni, parents and students.
- 12. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury suggested that environment sustainability activities should be organized by NSS and departments. Ms. Kamini Thakur informed that NSS will organize activities for plastic waste management, plastic collection, E-Waste collection and various cleanup drives from the month of September and October 2023.
- 13. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury suggested focusing more on research-based activities to inculcate research culture and skills amongst students and faculties. Ms. Bhumika More said that "BrainWave Ideate, Inquire and Explore" would be initiated in which, throughout the year, students would be encouraged to participate in research competitions. Time line with plan of action was also discussed and decided.

- 1. Ms. Bhumika More began the proceedings by welcoming the members present.
- 2. The Minutes of the Meeting held on December 9, 2023 were confirmed.
- 3. Bhumika More mentioned about some of the initiatives undertaken under autonomy and NEP2020. IQAC members had made Criteria wise presentations on changes to be incorporated under autonomy and NEP 2020. Additional new formats were created for departments and committee as per the guidelines of autonomy and NEP 2020 along with academic monitoring committee. She further mentioned that New NAAC transformative reforms for strengthening assessment and accreditation of higher education institutions will be made effective as per NAAC guidelines in academic year 2024-25.
- 4. Dr. Koel Roy Choudhury mentioned about formation of Syllabus Design Committee with internal and external members for approval of all Co-curricular course with 2 credits in semester II for NSS, DLLE, Sports and Cultural activities. Dr Moushumi suggested forming BOS for co-curricular activities to stream line syllabus under CC. Dr. Koel informed that BOS for Co-Curricular Course will be constituted from next academic year. She encouraged departments to introduce new co-curricular course like CC in Life Skills, CC in Management through Movies, Technical Writing so that students can get more options to opt for from next academic year. Open Electives courses offered in semester 2 by various departments were also shared in the meeting.
- 5. Bhumika More spoke about a FDP organized on Work Smart using IT for administrative staff and FDP on Quality Sustenance Initiatives under NEP 2020 organised for all the faculties. Details of various Faculty exchange programmes with Pillai College, Chagu Kana Thakur Arts, Commerce and Science college, Tilak College, SK College and Ramsheth Thakur college were also shared. Some of the other major initiatives presented were National Multidisciplinary conference "Confluence 2024", Seminar on 'On-the-Job Training' (OJT) for all PG students, Zero waste management, Certificate courses and training for competitive exams.





- 6. Dr. Koel Roychoudhury further gave information about the new programmes to be introduced from the academic year 2024-25. At Under graduate level, new programmes such as B.Com with Entrepreneurship in association with BODHE Institute for Entrepreneurship Pvt. Ltd, B.Com with Management Accounting with Finance (CMA) in association with FPA Edutech Pvt. Ltd, B.M.S. with specialization in Retail Management, B.Sc. Data Science and at Post Graduate level, M.A in Journalism and Mass Communication will be introduced.
- 7. Ms. Bhumika More discussed the revenue budget for academic year 2024-25 and also proposed to include meeting allowance of Rs.3000/- per meeting to each external IQAC member. All IQAC members agreed upon and hence it would be taken up to Governing Body meeting for final approval.
- 8. Details of the internal and external audits Report Academic, Administrative, gender, Environment, IT and Social Audits along with the recommendations were put forth.
- 9. Major findings from Student Satisfaction Survey report were presented and discussed.
- 10. Mr. Mithun Pillai presented the findings from syllabus feedback from all the stakeholders- students, faculties, alumni and industry. He further mentioned that feedback was also collected from parents and peers from other autonomous colleges and presentation for the same was also done. Further, Suggestions were discussed. Dr. Trupti Wani would further present the action taken report of syllabus feedback in the Governing Body.
- 11. Ms. Bhumika More informed that AQAR for academic year 22-23 was submitted successfully.
- 12. Dr.Raman Bala appreciated various initiatives undertaken by the college. He spoke about heterogeneous learning and suggested a session on Cyber Security frauds for the PNS staff should be organized. He emphasized to make basic Microsoft Excel mandatory for all students and also suggested to include role play with actual targets, epics of Mahabharata to instill values to include under NEP.
