

Major

It is the subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that subject, provided that students should secure the prescribed number of credits (about 50% of total credits) through core courses in the major subject.

Vocational Skill Courses, Internship/ Apprenticeship, Field Projects, Research Projects connected to Major.

Minor

- i. It helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the major subject.
- ii. Minor subjects may be from the different disciplines of the same faculty of DSC Major (Core) OR they can be from different faculty altogether.



Generic/Open Elective Courses (GE/OE):

A course which can be chosen from a pool of courses & which can be specific or supportive to the subject of study or which enables exposure to some other subject/discipline or which nurtures student's proficiency or skill.

OE is to be chosen compulsorily from faculty other than that of the Major.



Vocational Skill Courses (VSC)

VSC including Hands on Training corresponding to the Major &/or Minor Subject:

Wherever applicable vocational courses will include skills based on advanced laboratory practicals of Major.

Courses which are aimed at providing hands-on training, competencies, proficiency to students to enhance skill & employability.

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)

Courses which are aimed at imparting practical skills, nurturing soft skills etc., to enhance the employability of students.

To be selected from the basket of Skill Courses approved by University/
Autonomous Colleges



Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)

- Core linguistic skills, achieve competency in Modern Indian Language (such as Marathi/Hindi among others) and in English Language.
- Focus for both languages should be on Linguistic & Communication Skills.

Value Education Courses (VEC)

 Knowledge enhancement through various areas of study such as Understanding India, Constitution of India, Environment studies, Sustainable Development, Digital and Technological Solutions

Indian Knowledge System (IKS):

• Ancient traditional knowledge in India in fields such as Literature, Culture, Indian traditional systems of medicine, Astronomy, Yoga, Arthashastra, etc.

Participate in field-based learning or projects to study actual field situations regarding issues related to socio-economic development in rural and urban settings. Evaluation Process





- A semester comprises 90 working days (around 15 weeks) and an academic year is divided into **two consecutive semesters**-
- 1 Odd (Semester I) + 1 Even (Semester II)
- Duration of 1 Lecture = 1 Hour/ 60 Mins.
- Credit: 1 credit = 15 Hours for theory & tutorials and 30 hours for practical



- EXAM PATTERN- 60:40 Pattern
- 4 credits- 100 marks (60 externals and 40 internals)
- 2 credits- 50 marks (30 externals and 20 internals)
