DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT : The resource person for the event was Mr Rishi Vohra – published author of best seller fiction novels – Once upon the tracks of Mumbai , Hi Fi in Bollywood & MBA graduate, currently Indian Wine Academy correspondent .Also a multi faceted personality who worked as a producer Sony Entertainment Television & Sales Manager – Parrot Cellular & much more.

At the onset the author was introduced by the Librarian Ms Neelima B.This was followed by a short speech by Ms Koel Roy - the Vice Principal.The author then took over and he used the medium of a power point presentation to explain.He spoke in detail about how a story needs to be told effectively, how characters were to be shaped and how the plot should be penned down.He then went on to explain about writing, the various genres of story telling and writing and how to write effectively.He emphasized on the value of reading and how one could easily make out the difference between people who read and who do not.The event was also attended by Ms Prajakta – the college counsellor.

He concluded by sharing his life experiences and how he got into the field of writing. This was followed by an interactive session where in students asked questions and shared their thoughts. The

author explained in detail about self publishing, script writing and popularizing ones blog via social media. Finally as usual, he was presented a letter of appreciation by the Librarian Ms Neelima B.

OUTCOME : The response to the event was highly positive. The audio visual room was filled with students who wanted to listen to the author. They found it extremely fruitful and gained knowledge about how to write well and get their stories published. It was an informative session especially for would be writers / authors. EVENT : Book Review Presentation & Display of the Library reference collection

DATE: MARCH 16, 2018 (11 am to 3 pm)

PURPOSE : To have a small forum for avid book lovers / readers to express their views. And also to showcase the reference books owned by the library and to create general awareness about the reference collection

HIGHLIGHTS

VENUE : The college library reading room

ORGANIZED BY : ORGANIZED BY : The library committee & the library team (The Librarian Ms Neelima B, The Assistant Librarian Ms Swapna D & the library staff)

ORGANIZED FOR : The Book Review Presentation - for the under graduate & junior college students , Display of the reference collection – for all the students

NO OF PARTICIPANTS : - 8 to 10 undergraduate students for the Book Review Presentation

NO OF BENEFICIARIES : The Book Review Presentation - all the under graduate & junior college students , Display of the reference collection – all the students

DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT : The two events were simultaneously organized by the library committee , one being the Book Review Presentation & the other being the Display of the Library Reference collection.Small pamphlets about the event were put up at various prominent spots in the college premises as usual.

The Book Review Presentation was a competition in which interested students were asked to talk about their favourite book. Notices were circulated in advance and students had to register for the same. The judging criteria was also given to them in advance. Around ten students did so. A small section of the library reading room was to be used for the purpose and arrangements were accordingly made. The judge for the event was Ms Indumati Balachander - faculty member -BAF (Bachelors in Accounting & Finance) department, joined by the Librarian Ms Neelima B.

The students each spoke about their favourite book. Each of them narrated the story that caught their eye in detail and the insight it gave them. They elaborated on the plot and the characters. They explained their reasons for choosing that particular book as well as their personal comments, as required by the criteria. They all spoke eloquently, with a lot of sincerity & involvement. Prizes (motivational books) were to be given for the first three winners. How ever as all the participants were equally good no winner was declared. It was decided that prizes would be given to all within 2 - 3 days after more prize books were identified. At the end of the event all the participants were appreciated and congratulated and finally a group photo was clicked, later shared with the contestants (on a social media group created for the purpose)

The library Reference collection was also displayed on the same day.Various subjects like Management, Advertising, Journalism, Banking, Accounts, Economics were set up on different tables and labelled subjectwise. A portion of the reading room space was utilised for the same.The collection, being expensive is usually maintained under lock and key, given for reading only as per requirement.Hence this was a chance for the library users to view the same at one go.Faculty members & students visited the display and keenly browsed through the books.A Visitor's book was also maintained for feedback.

MEDIA COVERAGE : NONE

OUTCOME : The two events were small scale ones but the end result was positive. The students who participated in the Book Review Presentation gave a positive feedback. They were happy to get this opportunity to speak and interact with like minded students. So also the library users were made aware of the Reference Collection which would motivate them to access the same for research / academic activities especially related to their project work. Again the feedback given was appreciative of the efforts taken. This small initiative was hence successful in its own way.
