It is hoped that suggestions received from the users will help in further improvisations and make the application even more accessible and patron friendly.

SEMESTER 2 - 2019 - 20

A session on CYBER WARFARE & MOBILE HACKING was conducted by the Library Committee for undergraduate students.

It was conducted in the audio visual room on the 17^{th} of December 2019. The purpose of the event – to instill in students an awareness about mobile & internet security, the pitfalls and the precautions to be taken.

The session was conducted in the morning for a period of two hours. Present for the session were the Library Committee members – the Convenor & Vice Principal Dr Koel RC, Ms Neelima B the Librarian & the Co Convenor along with the Assistant Librarian Ms Swapna Desai.

The session was introduced by Ms Neelima.Dr Koel then explained to the students present the need to be careful while using technology and how we all could fall prey to hackers.She emphasized the need to have such a session so that the younger generation learnt to use technology responsibly.

The resource person invited was Mr Sankalp Mate – Cyber Security Consultant

(Pristine Info Solutions), whose qualifications included a degree in computer science, Ethical Hacking, Penetration Testing, Cyber Crime investigation, Cyber forensics and detailed knowledge of security tools, technologies & best practices. He was joined by his head and team mates from Pristine Solutions.

He went on to explain in detail how hacking can happen and security gets breached. He made the session interactive and also used slides and videos to get his point across. Students put forth their enquiries and and were also briefed on careers in Cyber & Mobile systems.

The vote of thanks was given by Ms Neelima, who also handed over a letter of appreciation to the speaker.

The highlight of the event – educating students about the need to exercise caution while using technology.



LIBRARY COMMITTEE EVENT – SALE CUM EXHIBITION OF DONATED BOOKS SEMESTER 2 2019 -20

On the 8th and 9th of January 2020, a Sale cum Exhibition of Donated Books was organized by the Library Committee for students of all the streams and also for staff members.

The college library had a stock of approximately 320 donated books (fiction, non fiction and general subject reference books - list attached) donated by various faculty members and students.

These were sorted, arranged & displayed. The venue was the reading hall of the college library.

The purpose of the event was to inculcate the reading habit among students and also to provide them with books for their studies / project work / academic activities. The books were sold at the rate of Rs 50 per book, fixed in consultation with the Principal and the college head office.

Students (nearly 200) from various streams attended the exhibition and purchased books, that they found useful.

Present for the exhibition were the Library Committee members – the Convenor & Vice Principal Dr Koel RC, Ms Neelima B the Librarian & the Co Convenor and the Assistant Librarian Ms Swapna Desai. The 2 day display was conducted with the help of the library peons Mr Vishwas, Mr Jayram & Mr Pravin.

Over 100 books were purchased by the students and the revenue generated from the sale was nearly Rs 7000, which later could be utilized for the library itself. The feedback from the students indicated that they found the initiative very useful. The highlight of the event was it generated excitement amongst students who were able to buy books of their choice at a nominal rate thereby luring them towards books.
