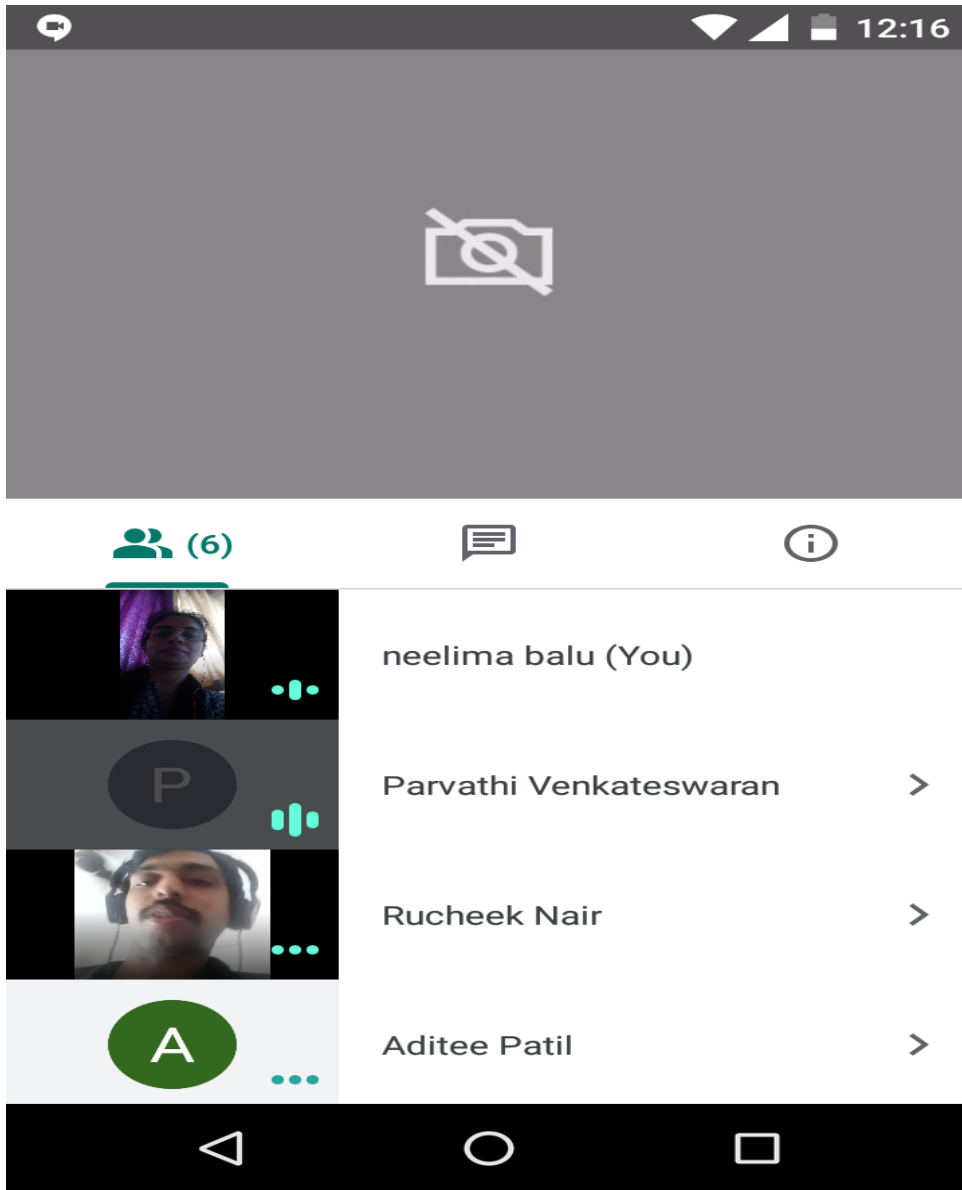

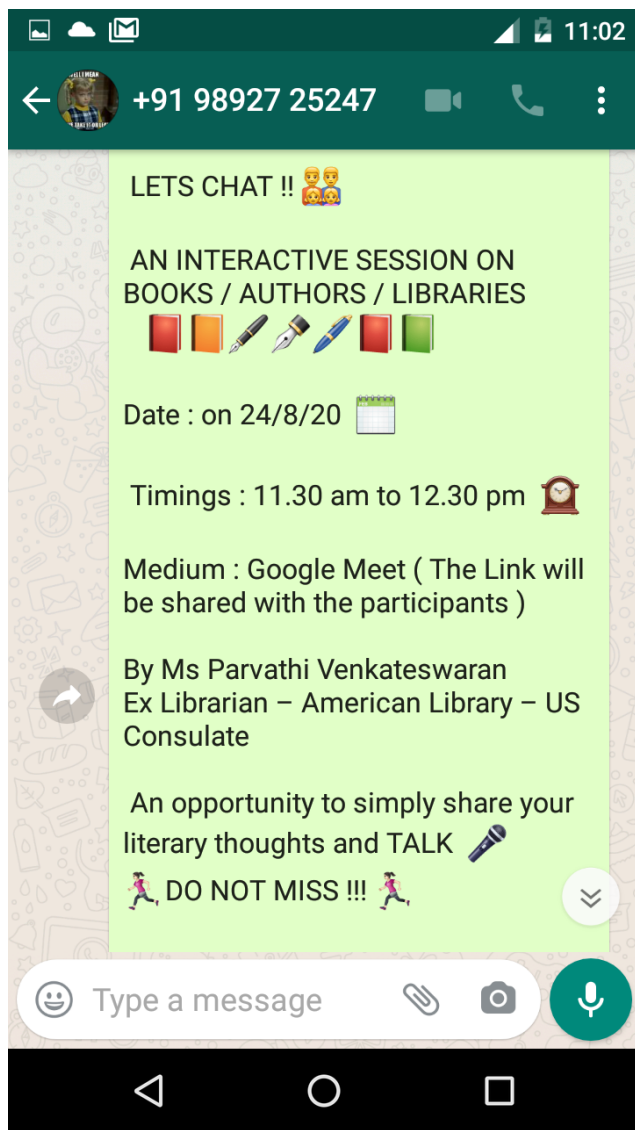
Ms Neelima B the Librarian conducted the session..Students were asked to fill an Online Feedback form at the end.

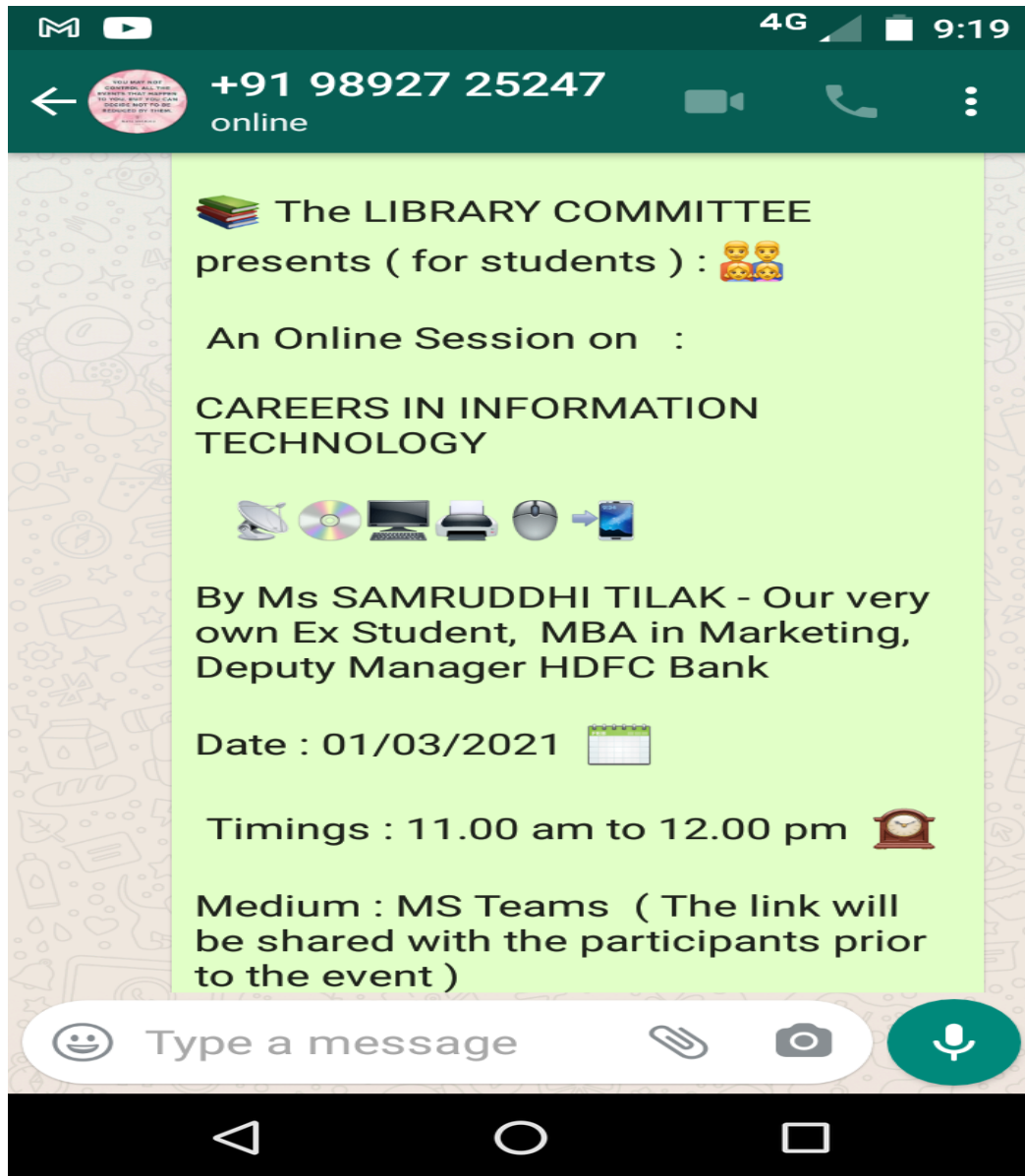

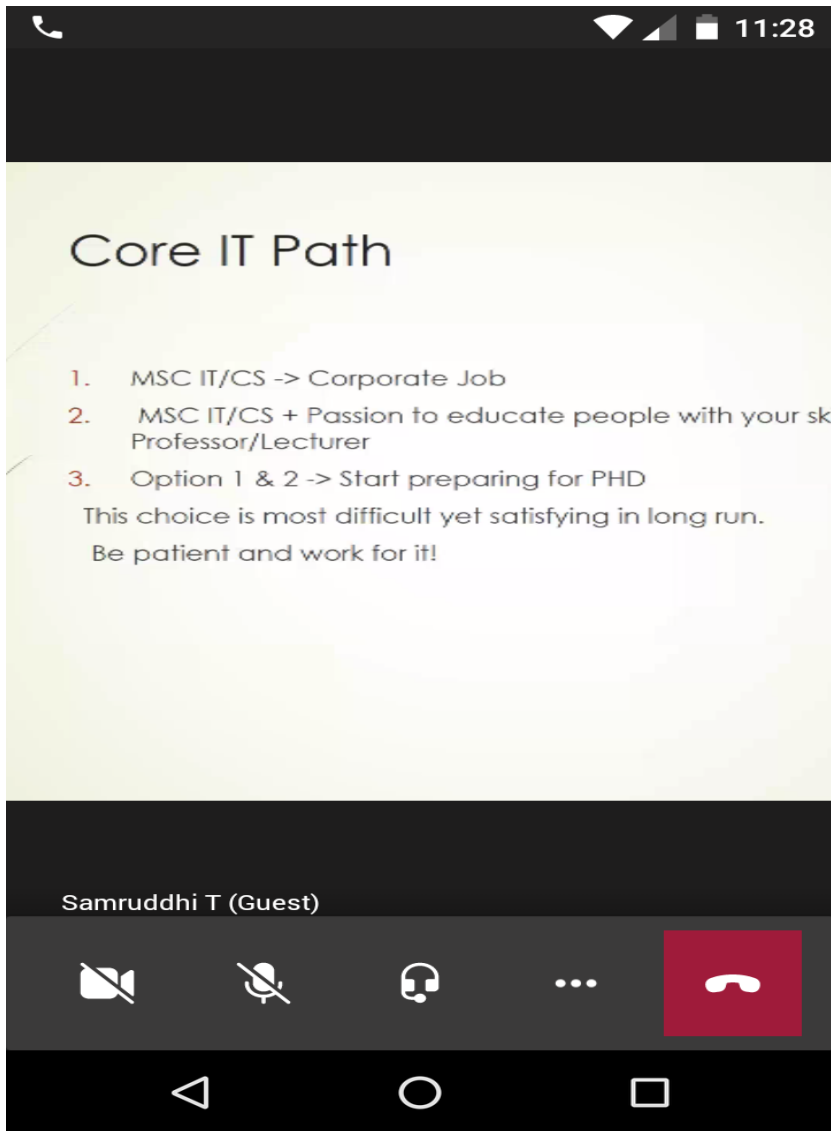
Ms Neelima B the Librarian conducted the session. Students were asked to fill an Online Feedback form at the end. All those who filled the form received an E certification of participation.

The feedback was highly positive and the students hoped that there would be more such sessions.

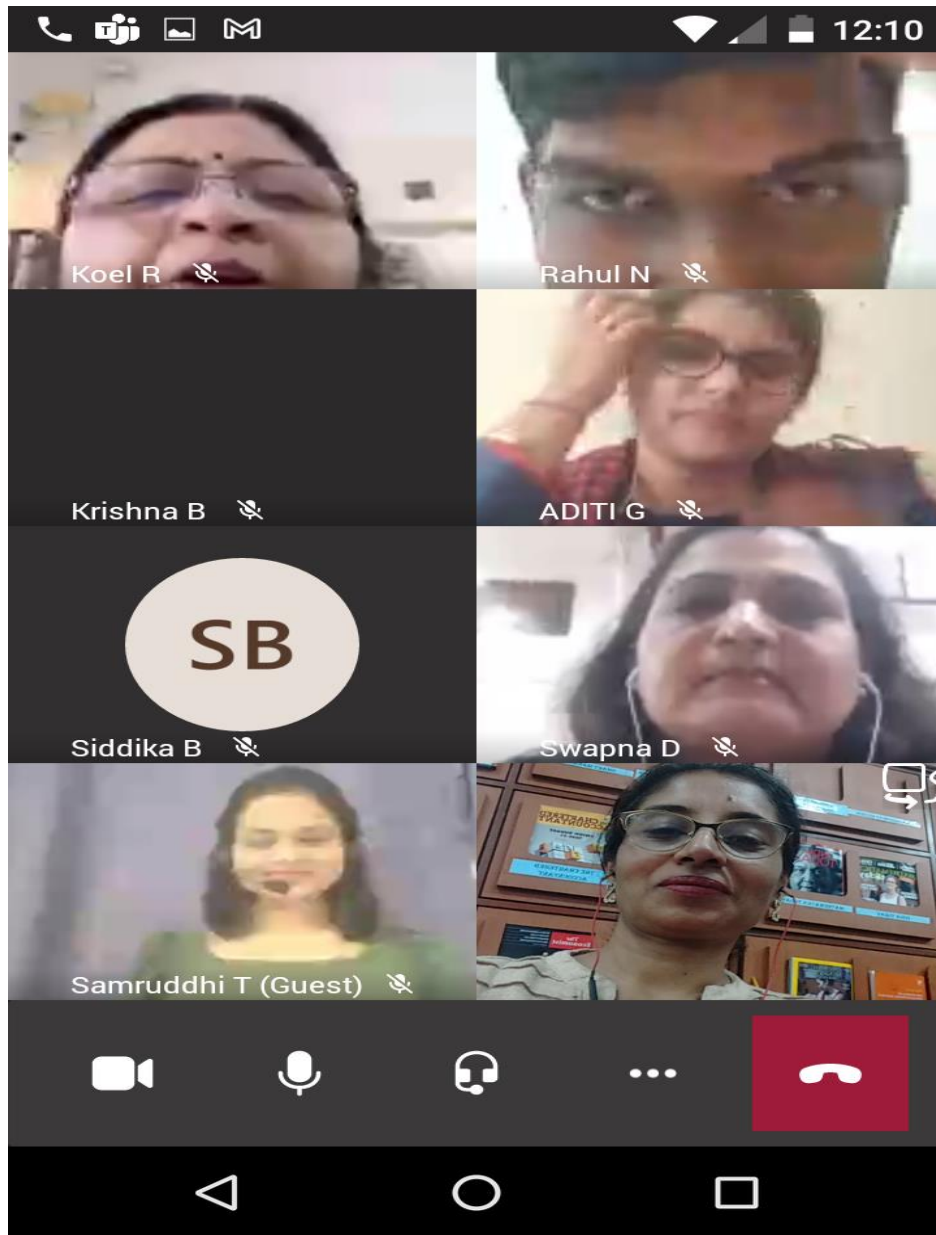

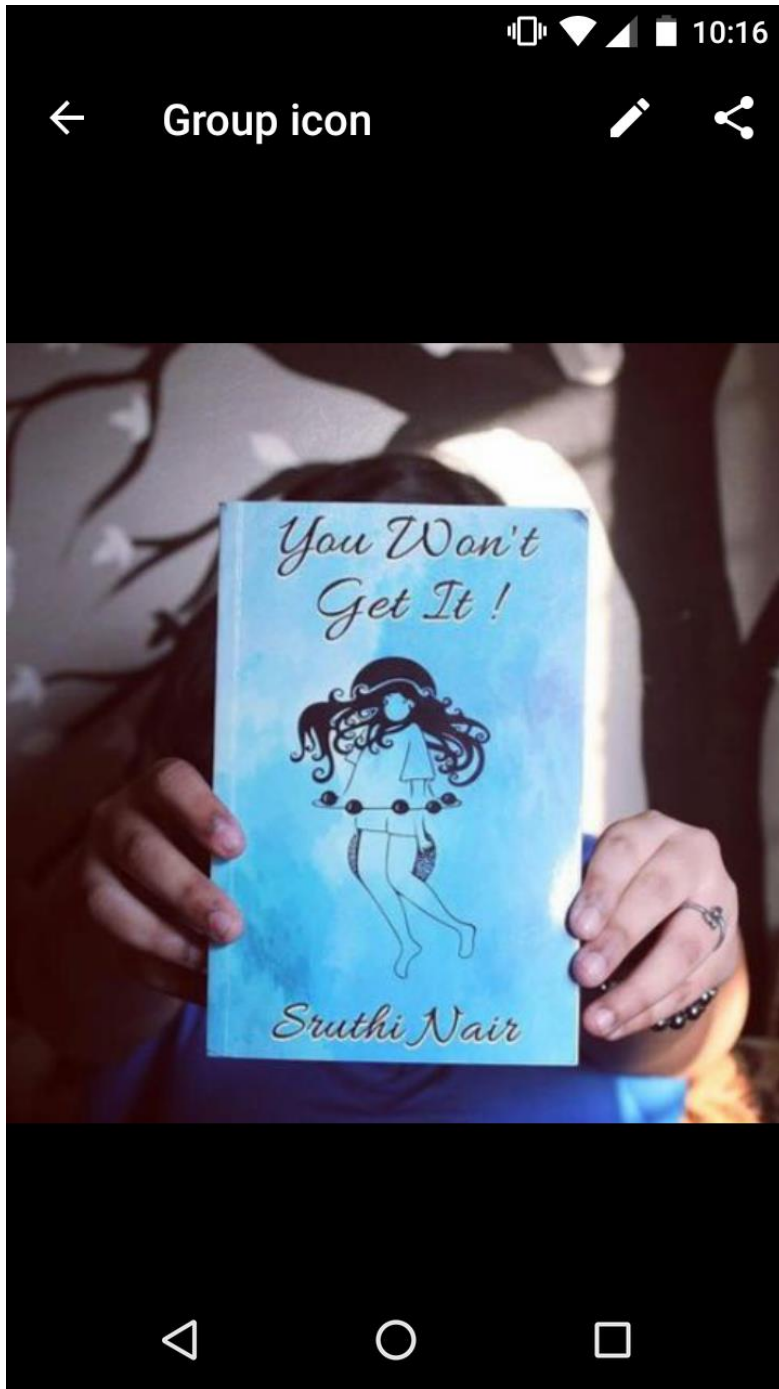

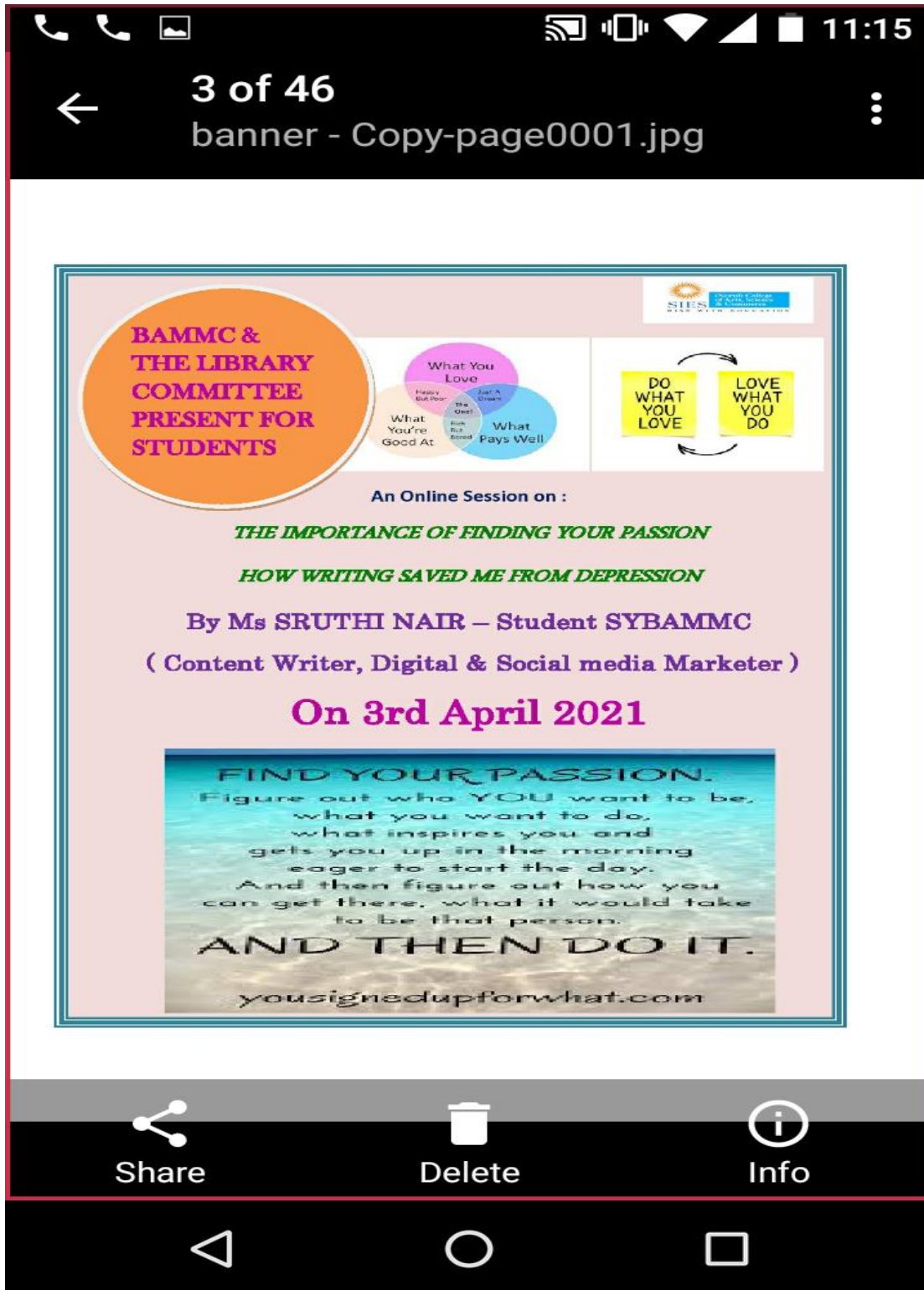
