27. Many students preferred offline lectures over online lectures. Based on situation and university regulations, blend of both methods- hybrid method is adopted.
28. Technical and connectivity issues during lectures. Improvement in infrastructure is needed for better delivery of lectures.
29. Interactive methods of teaching should be encouraged.
30. More practical sessions especially with syllabus with numerical.
31. Organising more skills and career guidance seminars to increase skill based learning.
32. Guidance lecture on NET/SET should be conducted.
33. More electives options should be included in syllabus.
