SPRINTS 2019-2020



13th February, 2020.

The Sports Committee organized the most awaited Annual Sports Event (SPRINTS) on 12th and 13th of February, 2020. SPRINTS provided a platform to various sport personalities of SIES (Nerul) to showcase their talents in a sporting spirit. It was a Inter-Departmental Sports Competition.

There were intense matches between 10 departments of SIES (NERUL) college. The event included diverse strength, agility, mind and motorised sports. These sports included Athletics, cricket, football, tug of war, chess, table tennis, throwball, volleyball, carrom and badminton. These sports were termed as Sacred Games as a theme.

Every sport was handled by their respective Heads. There was amazing response overall. In total, about 1000 students participated in SPRINTS. Day 1 consisted of Athletics, tug of war, badminton(singles &doubles), carrom(singles &doubles), chess(girls & boys), basketball and football; which was organized in Lawn area, quadrangle and gymkhana between 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Day 2 consisted of volleyball, throw ball, table tennis and cricket; which was organized in quadrangle, gymkhana and ashok vatika between 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

In events such as cricket, basketball, football, throw ball and volleyball it was compulsory criterion to have at least one girl player in order to motivate and give equal opportunity to girls.

Only for girls
