Institutional Social Responsibility

The pandemic has changed how we work, learn and interact as social distancing guidelines have led to a more virtual existence, both personally and professionally. However, this pandemic couldn't stop students from learning and online events & programs came as a boon in to their life.

Umang and Guru were two activities conducted by Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) in association with Kotak Education Foundation in the academic year 2020-2021 for which the students had to volunteer online.





OUR ASSOCIATION WITH KOTAK EDUCATION FOUNDATION

Guru was a 5month long ongoing program starting from *20th October 2020* wherein around *32 volunteers* helped 10th-grade students to prepare for their SSC board exams. The volunteers had to devote one hour twice a week where they would connect to students via phone call to help them in their studies. A volunteer was allotted a group of *5 students*. Regular sessions were conducted with students which will definitely help them improve their performance in the coming board examination.

Umang was a two-week program starting from *18th January 2021* and ending on *30th January 2021*. *13* ISR volunteers supported the students from different schools in their overall development.

The volunteers had to devote two hours in day for completing various activities which were assigned to them by the teachers such as preparing

the students for various class events like Class presentation, English Festival (debate), Recitation competition etc.

The activities were conducted to enhance the responsibility of the students for the society and also for creating a feeling of belongingness with the other volunteers. It helped not only the students of different schools but also the volunteers in many ways. This program helped the volunteers to learn new skills and boost their confidence. Around *150 students* from various schools were benefitted through this academic year. The program was conducted properly and all the activities were completed on time without any much difficulty.

These projects helped in creating new bonds and also taught how to work effectively for the society. The project helped the volunteers to work well with other people and gain new experience.

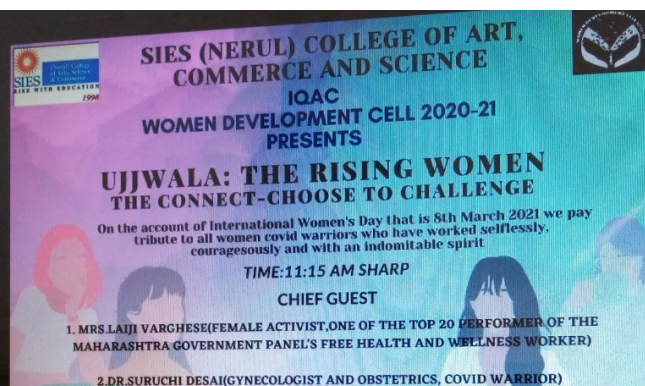

This took around another week or two. SOPs of Covid-19 were followed during the whole donation drive.

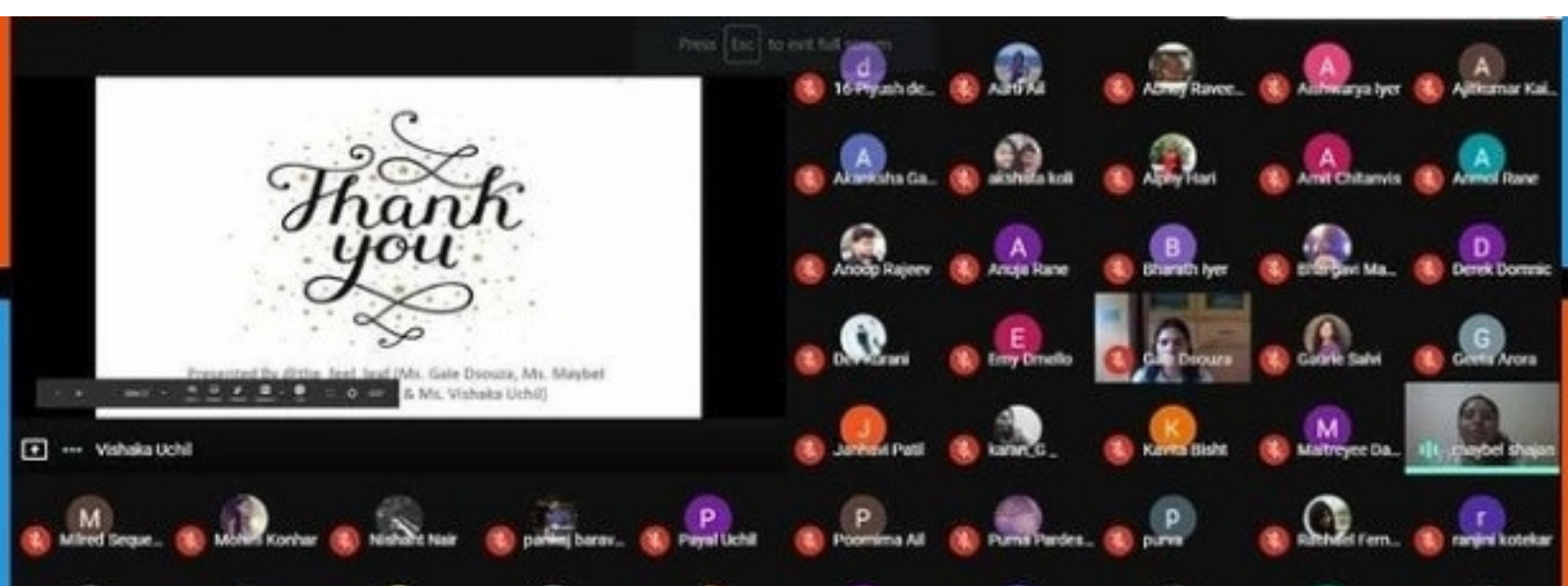
STUDENT COUNCIL

A team of 30 students, including Core and Heads, travelled to the 'Hands That Heal' Animal Care Foundation in Karnala, which is home to all kinds of animals such as cats, dogs, rabbits, cows, horses, monkeys, ducks, etc. Established in 2016, the Hands that Heal Animal Care Foundation is a shelter for homeless and injured animals on the outskirts of Panvel near the Karnala Bird Sanctuary. This program was organized to spread awareness and the message of feeding, protecting, and caring for the homeless. In addition, everyone must be more sensitive to animals and to those who take care of them. After all, compassion is the best religion for all reasons. and all seasons.



Reflective Collar Drive, a CSR initiative by the SIESONS team, took place on February 25th, 2021 during which reflective dog collars were attached to stray dogs so that they were visible to drivers at night. In a busy city like Mumbai, stray dogs are always at risk of being run over by traffic, especially at night. 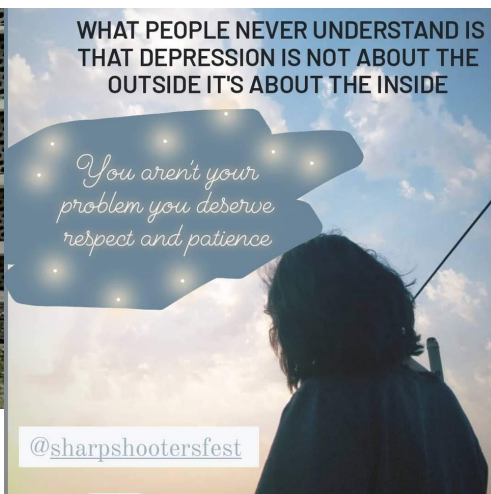


ADVAITA 2021

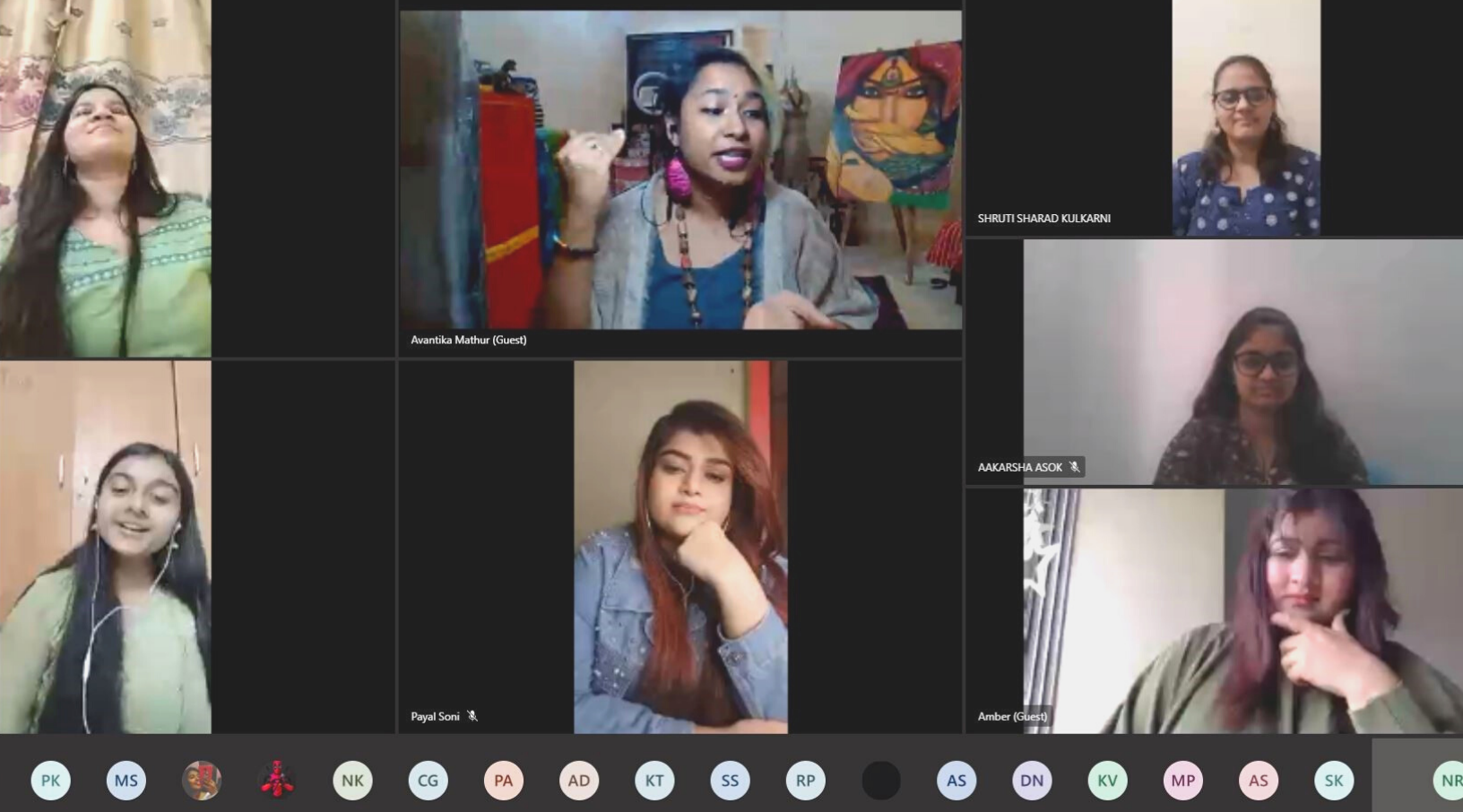
