An interactive session on N-List (National Library and Information services Infrastructure for scholarly content.) by the Library Committee


On October 12th, The library committee organized an online session on the e resource N-List (National Library and Information services Infrastructure for scholarly content.)







On December 20^{th} , the library committee organized an online session on the topic Reading , Writing and Authorship.


Its purpose being to improve the writing, communication and vocabulary skills of the students. The seminar was open to all the students of the college.



Approximately 49 students were in attendance – about 29 female and 40 male attendees. Towards the end the attendees shared their views and opinions.


After which there was a detailed Question and Answers session wherein some of the queries/doubts of the students were answered by the guest speakers. The offline event reached its end with the vote of thanks.
