
ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY OF THE COLLEGE: -



Guidelines for Ban on Plastic Use

Guidelines

- 5. To use Dry and Wet dust bins in college campus so as to segregate waste.
- 6. To have a strategy for E- waste management.
