All the students performed really well. This competition really found to be useful for developing programming skills among the students.





This is yet another event very well conducted by the ELA members which was a grand success by the immense participation by the students.





The events commenced just after the inauguration event. Students of other departments participated in these events. The registration of the events was



The event ended on an emotional note with a cake cutting ceremony along with all the Technovision members and the faculty members of the







This was then followed by the Contingent films' screening, which received entries from colleges in Mumbai. These films were based on a plethora of issues like equality, self defence, Nerul






participants. The day ended with its showstopper that is Nina suerte live, which was a free non-ticketed concert.

The events were kick-started soon after. Students from S.I.E.S. as well as from colleges across Mumbai attended the fest and participated in large numbers.


