SIESONS 2021

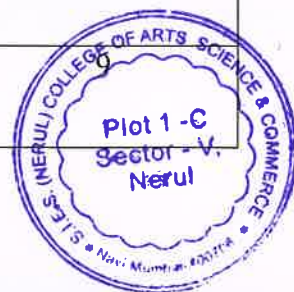

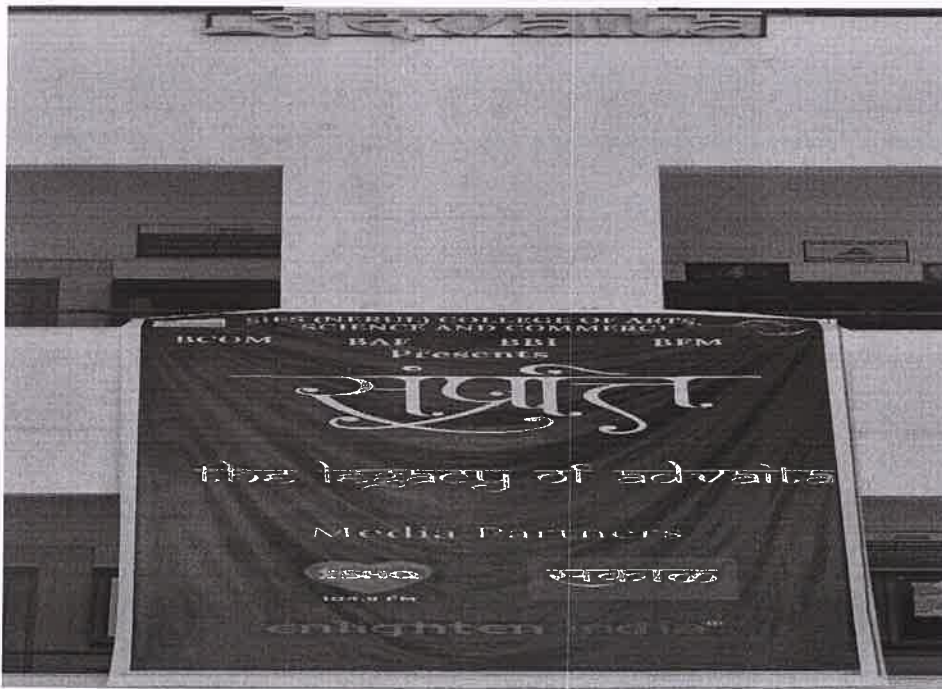
Since the pandemic hitting us was a low down for many college students, we thought of making ADVAITA as a National level online fest, we

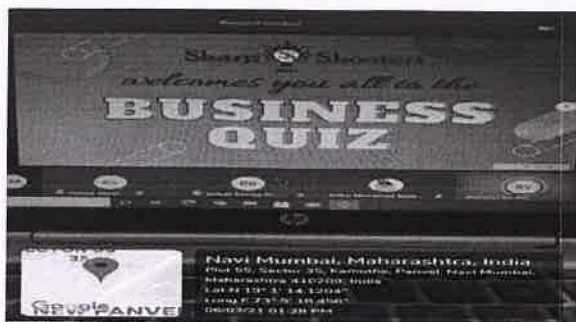

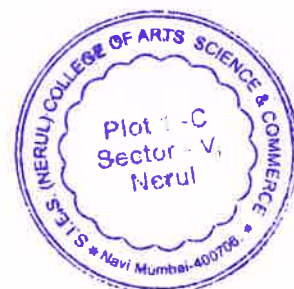
His performance involved interactions with the audience, which they really enjoyed.

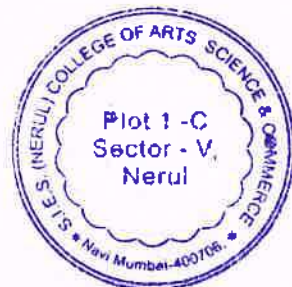

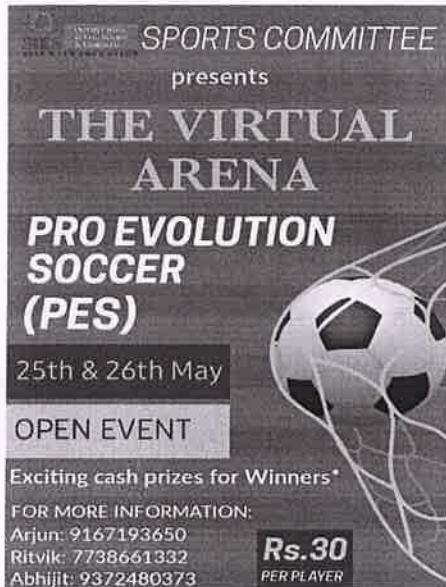
Firstly the event was started by preparing the broadcast and Google forms were spread to various people in order to forward the information regarding the event.

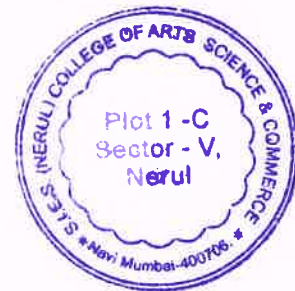
The various games in these tournaments were played on different apps and were headed by the respective members of our committee.

Teacher's Day 2020

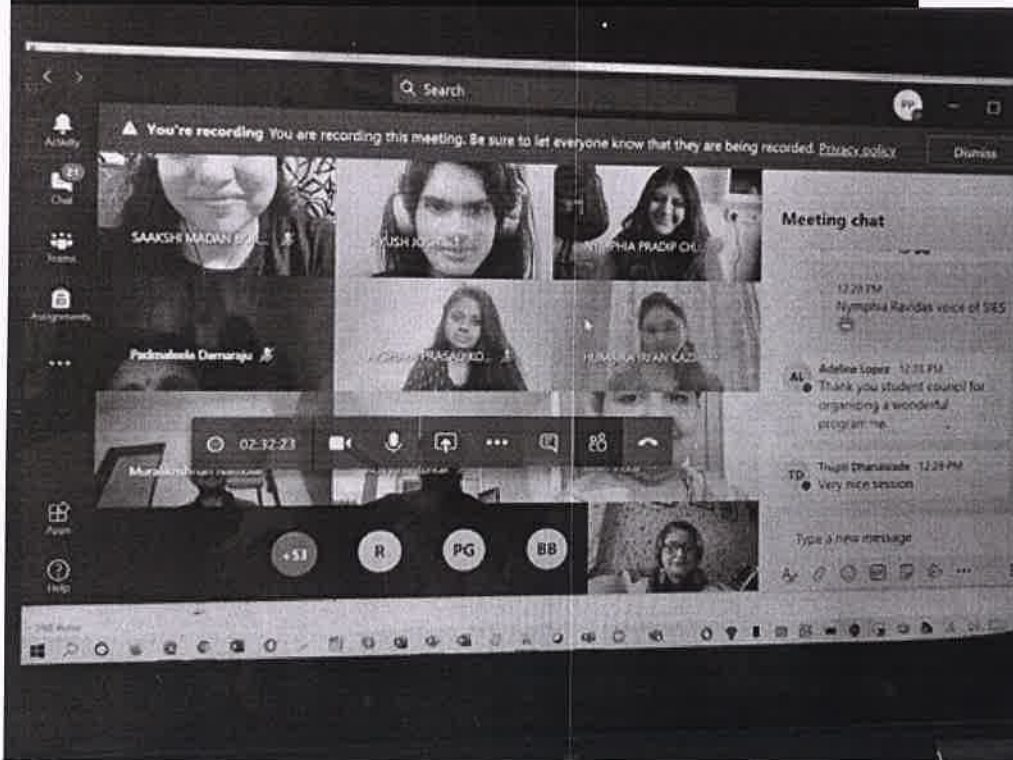

Report on International Online webinar on Management from Mahatma Gandhi and Abraham Lincoln's Perspective

An International online webinar on 'Management from Mahatma Gandhi and Abraham Lincoln's Perspective' was organised on 14th August 2020 from 4:30 pm to 7:30 pm(on MS Teams). The Webinar was organised by the IQAC cell of the College in collaboration with Forum for F.A.S.E.S.(Faith, Ahimsa, Satyagraha, Equality, Swarajya) on the eve of our 74th Independence day to throw light on how traditional values can impact modern management techniques. The Country was also celebrating 150 years of Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary.

As the Corona Pandemic was raging two of the largest democracies of the world, India and America, are at the forefront of the efforts to save lives. The following experts were invited to address the Webinar.

1. Prof. Dr. Christopher J. Ward [Professor of History, Clayton State University],
2. Dr. Peter Cunningham [Senior Academic Research and Trainer, Nelson Mandela University, South Africa],
3. Dr. Charanjeet Kaur [Former I/C Principal and Head, Dept. Of English, CHM College],
4. Dr. Prashant Kelkar [Head, Department of Political Science, CHM College, Ulhasnagar.

The event commenced with a welcome address by our Principal Dr. Milind Vaidya, which was followed by a Keynote address from the President of SIES Dr. V. Shankar. He spoke about the greatness of two brilliant individuals Gandhi and Lincoln. He stated that both believed in noble causes but differed in their means to achieve their goals.

The first guest speaker Prof. Christopher J. Ward addressed the influence of Abraham Lincoln and the impact of western civilization all over the world. He gave a broad viewpoint on how the management of the 19th century under Abraham Lincoln can still have uses for modern civilization. He addressed the situation of Coronavirus in his home state of Arizona and the rest of the United States. He talked about the role of Abraham Lincoln in the history of the United States and common traits he shared with Gandhi. Using President Lincoln's example, he quoted -" Lincoln is known for his very distinctive characteristics, both physically and psychologically". He emphasised on the relevance of Lincoln's thoughts and practices on Modern Management.

Dr. Peter Cunningham carried the webinar forward by explaining the managerial aspects of civilization. He provided insights on how governments all over the world should consider critical management as a priority during situations like Pandemic. Dr.Cunningham, engaged the conversation on ethics and formal regulations of the management on the society, also briefing on how the countries across the world could have faced the Pandemic in more

suitable ways and said “The one thing that influences the outcome is the value system and secondly, the interpretation of reality”.

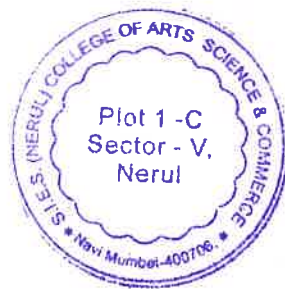
Lincoln and Gandhi’s ideologies and beliefs were further analysed by Dr. Charanjeet Kaur, who briefed about some similarities between their strategies that helped them to push through the difficult times. She provided an analysis on how the Gandhian ideas evolved through the nation before and after independence quoting “.

Dr. Kaur acknowledged the impact of Gandhi and his decisions even on policies of present day government. She shed a light on how COVID-19 would’ve been approached in a distinct manner under the management of Abraham Lincoln and Mahatma Gandhi based on their distinctive ideology. She also provided some guidelines on how communities and groups can communicate and play a vital role in any emergency. She said “We live in a democracy. It’s important to listen to all voices.”

Summarizing the speakers’ point of view, Dr. Prashant Kelkar enumerated the points from each session. He pointed out some major takeaways from the Webinar and helped in realising the importance of the opinions given by each speaker on the topic. Dr. Kelkar also included his perspective on the topic by stating how conflicts evolved through the evolution of Human Society. He also explained the role of Abraham Lincoln as one of the best and influential Presidents of all time.

The listeners were also allowed to ask questions/queries at the end of each session. There were many relevant questions asked and generated interesting discussions. The webinar was attended by 163 outside participants from various colleges and institutions from India .The webinar thus provided food for thought for all participants and enriched academic discourse.

Concept Note:

Ever since the scourge of COVID-19 settled on the world, sparing no one, nations and peoples everywhere have been reeling under the fact that the pandemic is forcing us to question the very bases of the progress that we, as the human race, have prided ourselves on. The priority, of course, is to contain the pandemic, to flatten the curve, to save as many lives as possible; to ensure that healthcare and basic amenities reach the poorest of the poor in every corner of the world. The economic disasters that are looming over us, add to the already strained human and nation's capacity to endure, as we seek to come out victorious in this fight for survival.

This Webinar is being organised to offer a ray of hope to our embattled species, and to two of the largest democracies of the world, India and America, which are at the forefront of the efforts to save lives: we look towards Abraham Lincoln and Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi as individuals who achieved the seemingly impossible in the most hostile circumstances. Apart from the obvious similarities in their professions, their humanism and their martyrdoms, their lives are exemplary of what can best be described as 'grace under pressure'. Both stand out for their ability to formulate what Leo Tolstoy calls 'the spirit of the age', reinforcing the values of truth, morality and courage in the cause of humanity, and inspiring millions to live up to these ideals, in personal, social and political contexts.

Now, when stark ethical choices stare us in the face - like, do we prioritise people's health and survival over the economic resurgence that we will need to work towards - the lessons from the lives of the two prime movers and achievers of their times, become even more relevant. We have invited speakers from the US and India to reflect upon the set of practical skills and spiritual values which were instrumental in the mass mobilisation of people for saving their respective nations, and bringing to the forefront the belief in the equality of humankind. The urgency is to strengthen this faith in the context of the lockdown, the self-isolation and economic distress caused by the corona virus, especially since now, it is not a single nation or a group of nations, but the whole human race, that are under threat.

"My life is my message" is what Gandhiji said for himself, & this is equally true of Abraham Lincoln who was shot dead just four years before the birth of the Mahatma. The "message" informs both these lives and its significance to the current situation, is what we seek to explore in the course of this webinar.
