


Next, the audience were treated with a session of games.



The conference aimed at spreading awareness towards the pressing issues of wetlands & Climate Change among researchers, academicians, students and other stakeholders in the society.

The event began by lighting of lamps by the dignitaries and was followed by a Welcome dance by our committee members.



There was also a video which was made by the students. The students added on various previous year alumni of the college. The teachers were overwhelmed on seeing the video as it recalled good old memories.






Teachers Day (2016-17)


Oath Taking Ceremony




Republic Day




